Articles of Marriage agreement between  
George Adams of the one part and Eliza  
Hollis of the other as follows whereas the  
said George Adams is seized to her and her  
heirs in Fee Simple of certain property &  
whereas a Marriage is shortly to intended to  
be had and solemnized between the said George  
Adams and Eliza Hollis with whom the  
said George Adams is to have and receive the  
said property and as for her Marriage portion  
it is covenanted and agreed by and between the
