Your name was given me by Dr. Vernon Reele as being able to help me with the history of the Hall family.

My mother was Julia Hall, daughter of John Hall, son of Mausel Hall, son of John Hall and Martha ^{Gladden} Hall. My mother was the daughter of Nancy Stokes, daughter of Martha Hall, daughter of John Hall and Martha (Gladden) Hall. I am doubly related to all these many children they had.

We have always thought that John Hall's Martha, was Sibby Hollis (Hall) but we have seen ^{wills} that make us doubt that is true. We have always believed we were closely related to the Hollis family, but cannot prove it, but it would have to have been before John Hall lived and we do not know anything about his parents or connection. My grand father John Hall and his wife Dept Fairfield District 'S.C., long before the Civil War, and we were quite young when they died. It is the connection of the Hall and Hollis family I am interested in and who were their parents of John Hall and (wife) Martha Gladden, and where John Hall came from.

in Virginia.

I have two fine sons. Dr. Ogden Baine, head of the Chemistry Dept., Southern Methodist University, Dallas Texas, and Dr. Rodney M. Baine, head of the Dept. of English, Alabama College, Montevallo, Ala.
