of two hundred and seventy five Dollars to me paid by Edward
Colvin of Chester District and State of the said State bargained
sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain
and release unto the said Edward Colvin a certain tract or parcel
of land containing one hundred and sixty two Acres of land
being the eastward part of two hundred acres of land granted to George
Johns the 15th day of Oct. 1784 said land situated in the District
of Savannah on the Branch of Beaver Creek of Broad River beginning
