Johnakin, Alexander

While residing in Camden District, he enlisted during June (6 July) 1775 and served in the Third Regiment under Capt. Robert Lyle. He was in the battle at Stono and in the skirmishes at Bacon's Bridge, Tallapoosa and other places. He was taken prisoner on 9 January 1776 and carried to Savannah where he was held on a prison ship for five months and seven days. While a prisoner, he was severely wounded. (Moved to Ga.)
