Kelvin T. Johnson has joined the United States Army under the Delayed Entry Program at the U.S. Army Recruiting Station in Elgin.

Johnson will report to Fort Leonard Wood in Waynesville, Mo. for military basic training July 16. *5/29/97*

He is the nephew of Jeanette and Joe Elgin Jr. of Winnsboro.

The Delayed Entry Program gives young men and women the opportunity to delay enlistment into the Army for up to one year before reporting to basic military training.

The enlistment gives the new soldier the option to learn a new skill, travel and become eligible to receive as much as \$30,000 toward a college education. After completion of basic training, soldiers receive advanced individual training in their career specialty.
