OSCAR CLEVELAND JOHNSON JR.

May 24, 1940 - October 1, 2013

Funeral services for Oscar C. Johnson, Jr., age 73, of Winnsboro will be at 2:00 p.m. on Friday, October 4, 2013 at Washington Street Baptist Church conducted by the Rev. Mr. Johnson left this earth to be with the Lord on October 1, 2013. Oscar was born May 24, 1940 in Union County to the late NathaLee F. Johnson and Oscar C. Johnson Sr. He was reared by his mother and also his grandparents, the late Bert M. and Venette T. Farner.

Mr. Johnson graduated from Union High School in 1959 where he served as Student Body President and band leader. He began working at A&P before graduation. Mr. Johnson was a member of Washington Street Baptist Church where he was a servant to the Lord. Seven members stepped in to take his positions when he became ill.
