Three Pounds Seven Shillings and one Penny half Penny Sterling for duty done in the Militia as per Adjutant's Certificate

the said *Ambrose Johnston* his Executors, Administrators, or Assigns, will be entitled to receive from this Office the Sum of *Four Shillings and Eight Pence*

on the *Demand* of *John Johnston* for one Year's Interest on the principal Sum of *Three Pounds Seven Shillings and one Penny half Penny* and the like Interest annually.

The said *Ambrose Johnston* his Executors, Administrators or Assigns, will be entitled also to receive, and shall be paid, if demanded, the principal Sum of *Three Pounds Seven Shillings and one Penny half Penny* on the *Twenty Second day of June 1787*

And the said *Ambrose Johnston* his Executors, Administrators or Assigns, may make any Purchases at any Public Sales of Confiscated Property, (except such as shall be ordered by the Legislature for special Purposes;) and this INDENT shall be received in Payment.

For the true Performance of the several Payments in Manner above-mentioned, the PUBLIC TREASURY is made liable, and the FAITH of the STATE pledged by the aforefaid ACT.
