The said his Executors, Administrators or Assigns to receive, and shall be paid, if demanded, the principal Sum of *thirty five Pounds eighteen shillings and eight Pence*

on the *fourteenth day of December 1787* And the said his Executors, Administrators, or Assigns may make any Purchases at any Public Sales of Confiscated Property (except such as shall be ordered by the Legislature for Special Purposes;) and this INDENT shall be received in Payment.

For the true Performance of the several Payments in Manner above-mentioned, the PUBLIC TREASURY is made liable, and the FAITH of the STATE pledged by the
