on the *Twenty Ninth July 1785* for one Year's Interest on the Principal Sum of *Three Pounds Sixteen Shillings and a Penny* and the like Interest Annually

The said *Elizabeth Johnston her* Executors, Administrators or Assigns, will be entitled also to receive, and shall be paid, if demanded, the principal Sum of *Three Pounds Sixteen Shillings and a Penny* on the *Twenty Ninth July 1786*

And the said *Elizabeth Johnston her* Executors, Administrators, or Assigns, may make any Purchases at any Public Sales of Confiscated Property, (except such as shall be ordered by the Legislature for special Purposes;) and this INDENT shall be received in Payment.

For the true performance of the several payments in manner abovementioned, the PUBLIC TREASURY is made liable, and the FAITH of the STATE pledged by the aforesaid ACT.
