The said *James Johnston* his Executors, Administrators, or Assigns, will be entitled also to receive, and shall be paid, if demanded, the principal Sum of *One pound ten Shillings and five pence*

on the *fifth day of September 1790* And the said *James Johnston* his Executors, Administrators, or Assigns, may make any purchases at any Public Sales of Confiscated Property. (except such as shall be ordered by the Legislature for Special Purposes;) and this INDENT shall be received in Payment.

For the true Performance of the several Payments in Manner above-mentioned, the PUBLIC TREASURY is made liable, and the FAITH of the STATE pledged by the aforesaid ACT.
