One Pound, Four Shillings, & Three Pence, Halffenny, Sterling for 19 days Militia Duty as Private in 1782, as per Account indebted.

the said *Jacob Johnston* his Executors, Administrators, or Assigns, will be entitled to receive from this Office the Sum of *One Shilling, & eight Pence*

of the Demand, for one Year's Interest on the principal Sum of *One Pound, four Shillings, & three Pence, Halffenny* and the like Interest annually

The said *Jacob Johnston* his Executors, Administrators or Assigns, will be entitled also to receive, and shall be paid, if demanded, the principal Sum of *One Pound, four Shillings, & three Pence, Halffenny* on the *1st day of July 1781.*

And the said *Jacob Johnston* his Executors, Administrators or Assigns, may make any Purchases at any Public Sales of Confiscated Property (except such as shall be ordered by the Legislature for special Purposes,) and this INDENT shall be received in Payment.

For the true Performance of the several Payments in Manner above-mentioned, the PUBLIC TREASURY is made liable, and the FAITH of the STATE pledged by this ACT.
