this Office the Sum of *Seven pounds, nine shillings
& nine Pence*
on *the Demand*,
one Year's Interest on the Principal sum of *One hundred &
seven pounds*,
and the like Interest Annually

The said *John H. Johnston*, his Executors, Ad-
ministrators or Assigns, will be entitled also to receive and shall be paid,
if demanded, the principal Sum of *One hundred & seven
Pounds*,
on the *twenty sixth of April 1787*.

And the said *John H. Johnston*,
his Executors, Administrators, or Assigns, may make any Purchases at
any Public Sales of Confiscated Property, (except such as shall be ordered
by the Legislature for special Purposes;) and this INDENT shall be re-
ceived in Payment.

For the true performance of the several payments in manner abovementioned, the **PUBLIC TREASURY** is made liable, and the **FAITH** of the **STATE** pledged by the aforesaid ACT.
