Thirty five Pounds, fourteen Shillings, & three Pence, one Farthing Sterling, for Militia Duty as Private, 1783, per Account

the said *Nathan Johnson*, his Executors, Administrators, or Assigns, will be entitled to receive from this Office the Sum of *Three Pounds, nine Shillings, & three Pence,*

on Demand *for* one Year's Interest on the principal Sum of *Thirty five Pounds, fourteen Shillings, & three Pence, 1/4* and the like Interest annually

The said *Nathan Johnson*, his Executors, Administrators or Assigns, will be entitled also to receive, and shall be paid, if demanded, the principal Sum of *Thirty five Pounds, fourteen Shillings, & three Pence, 1/4* on the *Twenty second* of *July 1787*

And the said *Nathan Johnson*, his Executors, Administrators or Assigns, may take any Purchase at any Public Sales of Confiscated Property, (except such as shall be ordered by the Legislature for special Purposes;) and this INDENT shall be received in Payment.

For the true Performance of the several Payments in Manner above-mentioned, the PUBLIC TREASURY is made liable, and the FAITH of the STATE pledged by the aforesaid ACT.
