Kennedy the two following negro Slaves, to wit, one woman called arr and one negro man named Hardy. one horse called Black, one bodsteed, bed and furniture, also three cows and calves, VIZ, Stakly, Peccy, and white back, with their calves, also four heed of sheep, to her the said Mary E. Kennedy for her own special use, benefit & pofsefaton, during the term of her natural life, and after her death to her lawful bodily if sue forever.

Kennedy be settled therefrom, and out of the overplus all my just debts be paid, and the remainder of the proceeds of Said Sales be equally divided between Camind M. Kennedy Louisa A. Kennedy. James A. Kennedy. Hary E. Konedy. Thomas W. Kennedy and Harriet C. Kennedy. Share and share alike.
