Infantry, owner of leather knapsack in military collection. Ketchin enlisted at age 22 on April 11, 1861. He was promoted from Corporal to Seargent to 1st Sgt. to 2nd Leut.. He was wounded on June 30, 1862...surv ived and activated to be mortally wounded on Sept. 30, 1864, at Fort Harrison, Va. He had been wounded in the thigh and died a few days later.
