Thanks so much for giving in memory of my dad, Robert "Bob" Edward Killian, Sr.

Did she (Catherine Stratton Ladd) live in your building?

The Ladd's (George & Catherine) lived on the corner where the Gazba is located and their lot also included the old theater next to museum.

There house was located on both of those lots and was burned by Sherman's troops.

Where was the school?

The school (where the museum is located) was spared from being burned (probably being made of brick).

What do you have on Catherine Ladd?

We have here at the museum in our collection two pictures of Catherine Ladd (both on display); one when she was the age when she taught here; second when she was very much a senior, maybe 80's.

The John Feaster and Mary Meador painting hanging in the dining room of the museum were painted by her husband George Ladd.

We have in our Family Files and other files a considerable amount of information.

Will you be returning soon or do you want me to scan and email information to you?
