

## LADDS OF VIRGINIA.

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700 acres of land were granted to John Ladd (4380) in Lynhaven Parish, Lower Norfolk Co., Va., May 25, 1678.

500 acres of land were granted to William Ladd (4381) on the north side of James river, in the fork of Beaver Dam Creek, in Henrico Co., Va., June 16, 1714.

1095 acres of land were granted to Amos Ladd (4382) in Henrico Co., Va., June 16, 1714, in consideration of the transportation of the following persons. (Headrights,) entitling those paying their passage fifty acres each, viz. : John Jones, Andrew King, John Polwin, John Linch, Edward Brooke, William Pinkinton, Thomas Foster, Francis Corley, Richard Franke, Ellen Browze, William Toby, Isaac Sweet, Garret Aubird, John Gedshill, Benjamin French, James Cloyson, M. Masall, Robert Silk, Robert Spardman, William Dobge, and Mark Lifeholly, and the payment of five shillings.

Amos Ladd had other parcels of land granted him, viz. : 348 acres on the north side of James River, Henrico Co., Va., Aug. 17, 1720 ; 300 acres at the same place, Nov. 13, 1721 ; two lots of 400 acres each on the south side of Fluvanna River, in Goochland Co., Va., Sept. 8, 1728 ; 94 acres in same county, June 20, 1733.

- (4380) John Ladd, of Lynhaven Parish, Lower Norfolk Co., Va. There is a tradition among some of his descendants that he came from New England, but we do not think it is well grounded. He probably came from England, and very likely was a relative of John Ladd,<sup>4208</sup> who settled at Burlington, N. J., in 1678.

(4887) James Ladd, of Charles City Co., Va., (son of John,<sup>4880</sup>) ma.  
Isabella Denson, June, 1767. She died Aug. 3, 1809. He died  
Oct. 17, 1807. "He was one of the 'F. F. Vs.' (first families  
of Virginia.) He owned a farm called Green Meadow, a store,  
and the Eduer Flour Mills. He was considered rich at that  
time. He was a member of the Society of Friends and a minis-  
ter of that denomination." We read of him in the Diary of  
Barnaby Nixon, published in 1814, as follows: "In 1782, with  
James Ladd as a companion, we visited various meetings of  
Lower North Carolina. \* \* \* In 1789, in company with  
James Ladd, we visited the meetings at Rich Square and Jack  
Swamp." Towards the close of his diary he says: "Cousin  
James Ladd had been in a consumption, declining way, for sev-  
eral months, and was desirous to see me. His son, James Den-  
son Ladd, came to me in the 9th mo., 1806. After being with  
him several days, Joseph Ladd took me home. James Ladd  
lived a little more than two weeks after I left him. A little be-  
fore his death he said: 'All men must come to this, and I shall  
make a good end, which will crown all.'"

We make the following extract from the Diary of John Foth-  
ergill, a minister of the Society of Friends in England, who vis-  
ited this country. [See Friends' Library, vol. 13, pp. 379, 380.]

"In 1721, the 28 of the 6 month, we had a meeting at Widow Butler's house, to which came several soberly behaved people. We came back from thence to Robert Honicut's, and had a meeting near his house. The next day we crossed James River to William Ladd's, (4981,) where a small meeting is usually kept. The 27th we had a pretty large meeting at Carles, and lodged at Thomas Pleasants'; on the 28th, with some friends, we rode up the woods to a place called Dover, (Dover Mines, in Goochland Co., Va.,) where a few friends live,—we lodged that night with one John Parsons; on the 1st 7 month we had a meeting at a French settlement called Manikintown,—lodged with Daniel Groom; on the 2d we went to the monthly meeting at Edward Mosby's,—lodged that night with John Johnson, at the swamp. The 4th we went to Black Creek,—lodged with Gerard Ellyson, and had another meeting; 5th had another meeting on the Pamunkey River; came back to Gerard Ellyson's, and had another meeting the 6th at Black Creek; 7th went to a meeting at William Ladd's again,—lodged at John Crew's; and went again at a meeting at Carles,—lodged at J. Pleasants'."

We have introduced the above extract from Fothergill's diary to show where the Ladds, the Ellysons, the Crews, and the Pleasants, who inter-married with the Ladds, lived; and it may enable others to make a more perfect genealogical record of this branch of the Ladd family. He was treasurer of the Yearly Meeting in 1807.

(4890) Benjamin Whitehead Ladd, of Smithfield, Ohio, (son of James,<sup>4287</sup>) ma. Elizabeth, dau. of William and Mary (Smith) Wood, April 20, 1814. She died Dec. 4, 1832, and he ma. 2d, Hannah Wood, July 31, 1834. He died March 31, 1851. He came to Smithfield from Virginia in 1814, and purchased from his father-in-law the farm known as the "Prospect Hill," adjoining Smithfield on the west, and erected on it in 1815 a brick dwelling, which is still (1890) standing. In 1817 he built a building for the purpose, and commenced to pack pork and cure bacon. So far as is known, this was the first enterprise of the kind west of the Alleghany Mountains. This business proved successful, and was extended from time to time until he had erected four houses on the farm and one at Martin's Ferry, Belmont Co., Ohio. He was not only remarkably enterprising, but equally disposed to help others. He was the especial friend of the poor and downtrodden colored race, assisting many in their flight from slavery. He was a prominent member of the Orthodox Society of Friends, and faithfully served the church as an elder, as clerk of the Ohio Yearly Meeting, and in various other capacities. Amid all his business calls he found time to attend to his duties as a citizen and a Christian; benevolence and unbounded hospitality being marked traits in his character.

- (4409) William H. Ladd, of Brooklyn, N. Y., (son of Benjamin W.,<sup>4300</sup>) ma. Caroline E. Coffin, of Richmond, Ind., Aug. 24, 1848. He spent two years, 1841-2, at Haverford, Pa.; was a teacher at Friend's Boarding School at Mt. Pleasant, Ohio, the Winter of 1842-3. He purchased Ohio's wool for forty-seven years for eastern manufacturers; for twenty years for the Middlesex Co. of Boston, for fifteen years for the Slater Woolen Co. of Webster. In 1844 he purchased a large farm near Richmond, Jefferson Co., Ohio, where for twenty years he success-

fully dealt in and raised blooded horses and sheep. He imported at one time, from Silesia, three hundred sheep, the first of that breed ever brought into Ohio. He was intimately acquainted with John Brown, of Harper's Ferry fame, at one time having travelled with him three months through New England, selecting sheep. He was elected a member of the Ohio Board of Agriculture in 1850, and its president in 1856. He was a delegate at the convention held at Pittsburgh, Pa., in 1856, at which the Republican party was formed. During the war, in 1861, he was requested by President Lincoln and Secretaries Stanton and Chase (the latter two being special friends) to take charge of the contrabands at Port Royal, Va. On his way South to fulfill his mission he stopped at Cincinnati, Ohio, to assist in the organization of the Contraband Relief Commission, consisting of Levi Clifford, Abraham Taylor, Charles B. Boynton, Robert Carroll, and William H. Ladd. He was a prominent member and minister of the Orthodox Society of Friends. In 1865 he moved to Brooklyn, N. Y., where he lived until 1888, removing in that year to Haverford College, Pa., where he resided until his death, May 30, 1890.

He commenced business for himself a few years before the war, but when Fort Sumter was fired upon by the Confederate States, and war seemed inevitable, he felt a strong desire to perform his part in aiding the national government in crushing the Rebellion, or to state it more mildly, in "bringing back the erring South," with a firm and patriotic purpose he enlisted as 1st Lieut. in Co. B, Capt. Van Sickles, of 1st Reg. of N. J. V., Col. W. R. Montgomery, and was mustered in May 21, 1861. He was promoted to captain Aug. 11, 1862; was mustered out for promotion June 23, 1864, and was commissioned as major of the 38th Reg. N. J. V., Col. William J. Sewell, Sept. 27, 1864. He

took part in the following battles: First Bull Run, Benson's Farm, West Point, Gaines Mill, Charles City Co. Cross Roads, Malvern Hill, Manassas, Chantilly, Crampton Gap, Antietam, Wilderness, Spottsylvania Court House, Ann River, Hanover Court House, Cold Harbor, Fredericksburg, Chancellorsville, and Salem Heights. He was on recruiting service at Camp Perrine, Trenton, N. J., Sept. and Oct. 1863; was detached with four companies for service at the military post at Cannon's Landing, James River, Va. He was wounded twice in the battle of Salem Heights, May 4, 1863, first in the left arm and the second time in the calf of his right leg, which compelled him to leave the field for the hospital. Soon after the close of the war and the disbanding of the armies, Gov. Joel Parker offered him promotion by brevet, for brave and meritorious conduct, and urged him to accept, but he replied to all inducements held out that the war was over, the fighting all done, and he had no fancy for empty titles. Not long after the close of the war he bought a large tract of timber land in Virginia, and was engaged for eight years in sawing logs and finding a market for his lumber. He made good investments of his money in real estate and shipping, and has now retired from active business, but holds an interest in a gentlemen's furnishing store, and is the owner of a small pottery, the only one manufacturing Rockingham ware, in Trenton, N. J. He has been often urged to accept civil office, but has always declined, because he prefers the pleasure and comforts of his home to the honors of any office which would call him away from his family circle.
