He graduated from Clemson College in 1907 and was the oldest living Clemson graduate at the time of his death. He was a retired county farm agent, serving in this capacity for thirty-seven years. A member of Union Memorial Presbyterian Church where served as an Elder for fifty years, also Sunday School teacher and Superintendent of the Sunday School. He was a charter member of the Winnsboro Lion's Club, instrumental in forming Fairfield Electric Co-op, a director emeritus of the Central Credit Assoc. and a 32nd Degree Mason. He married (1) Margaret Coskrey,* daughter of Robert J. & Elizabeth (Johnson) Coskrey* of Summerton, SC, on 19 Dec 1912. She was born 5 Mch 1889; died 22 Dec 1954; buried at Union Memorial.
