

Know all men by these presents that I
Archibald McLeod of Fairfield District
in the aforesaid State in consideration
of Three Hundred and twenty four Dollars

in do severly fine Courts to one paid by Park
and A.R. Gallum of Fairfield District
in this State aforesaid have given Recd
of aforesaid Bill and released accordingly
these presents as good Bargain Bill and
release unto the said Richard D. R. Mc-
Llums a tract or part of a tract of land
by me and being on the West Side of the
Belle Mills Roads to contain about
One Hundred and Eight acre or thereabouts
Acres Situate in Fairfield District and
State aforesaid on the Branches of Sack-
Creek and tributary of Belle River and
having back from the Sack Creek about
twelve or thirteeen rods width and
thereof made and left to be Sack Creek
March 11th 1840 in full with all and
singular the rights members Mendham
and of performance to the said premises
belonging or in any wise incident or
appertaining to have and to hold all and
singular the premises before mentioned
left to the said Richard D. R. McLlums his
Heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby
bind myself my heirs Executors and
Administrators to warrant and forever
all and singular the said premises
unto the said Richard D. R. McLlums his
Heirs and assigns against myself my Heirs
and against every person whom soever
lawfully claiming to be owner the same or
any part thereof.

Please unto the said Richard D.R. Hall
knows a tract or part of a tract of land
by long and by on the West side of the
Belle Meille Roads to contain land containing
One Hundred and Eight acres and four rods
acres situate in Fairfield District and
State aforesaid on the Branches of Sacken
Brook and tributaries of Belle River and
having forch from the High Marks additional
dunes as will more fully appear by a plat
hereof made and certified by John Banks
March 11th 1840 before together with all and
singular the East, West, North and South
and other parts annexed to the said premises
belonging or in any wise incident or
appertaining to have and to hold all and
singular the premises before mentioned
unto the said Richard D.R. Hall his
heirs and assigns forever and I hereby
bind myself and my heirs executors and
Administrators to warrant and defend
all and singular the said premises
unto the said Richard D.R. Hall his
heirs and assigns against myself my
and any other person whom soever
lawfully claiming to claim the same or
any part thereof. This is my last and
last will and testament of my lands in the
year of our Lord One thousand eight
hundred and forty six A.D. in the
second year of the said year of our Lord
one thousand eight hundred and forty six.
