Thomas McMeekin was the son of Gen. Thomas McMeekin and Elizabeth Moody McMeekin.

This is sworn to by R. B. Lewis, He had his information from his father Daniel Lewis, who was the eldest son of Elizabeth Comfort Brummett by a former marriage - to John Lewis of Virginia in 1812. Her son Daniel was born in 1813 or 1815 on another page

Gen. Thomas McMeekin's mother was Miss Elizabeth Montgomery and married a McMeekin before coming to America.

Her son (Gen) Thomas came to America some with his mother and afterward he married Margaret Moody.

Mrs Elizabeth Montgomery McMeekin married a Hawthorn in America

With slave labor Gen. Thomas McMeekin built a handsome home, which is now the St Barnabas Mason- Colored.
