(5) Mrs. Evelyn Lewis Robinson, 1020 Quenby Road, Houston, Texas 77005, believes that Catherine McDonald Lewis was the mother of her ancestor, George Wright Lewis.

(6) The Nevill Family by Ivan B. Nevill, Sr., 717 East 17th, Houston, Texas. His great-grandfather, Colonel Zachariah Nevil (-1830) married Ann Scott Jefferson, daughter of Randolph Jefferson and niece of President Thomas Jefferson. His father, Zachariah Lewis Nevill (1833-1909) married (1st) Ann M. Lewis, 8 November 1853, Tuscaloosa, Alabama. She was a sister of Eldorado Lewis (1852-1936) who married Willis Skelton (1846-1900), the grandfather of the author.
