Vandenberg* the day of 1861 and served in that command until the *16th* day of *May* 1862 - I was discharged from the service at *Wentworth, N.C.* on the *10th* day of *May* 1862 and was at that time a member of Company *D* Regiment of *7th* Battalion of My income and my wife's from all sources is *zero* in excess of \$2000.00 - *zero* in excess of \$2000.00. The valuation of all my and my wife's property does *not* exceed \$2000.00 - *zero* exceed \$2000.00. I was born on the *23rd* day of *Sept* 1837 I reside at *Home, S.C.* in *Fairfield* County, S.C. I did not desert the service of this State nor of the Confederate States. While in such service I received bodily injury. (State nature of wounds and other disabilities, giving condition of present health)..... *Slightly wounded.*

I have not been on the pension roll of South Carolina, nor any other State, nor of the United States.
