

James Carroll Lewis, ^{above} above, and his brother John Quarles Lewis, served in the Civil War. James Lewis enlisted at Camp Lee April 28, 1862, and was paroled May 1, 1865, at Greensboro, N.C. He served in the 7th Florida Infantry, Co. D., Alachua Rebels, and fought with the Western Army and in the Battle of Atlanta. He was the grandson of William Blivings Lewis who came to Winnsboro from Charleston in 1776.
