1,027 Get Polio Shots During Special Week

In this short period, 1,027 children and adults were given polio vaccine and an average of approximately 25 per day are currently being inoculated. Infantile paralysis is on the increase in many areas and those who have not taken the shots would be wise to do so at once. Free vaccine is provided for all up to 19 years of age.
