His will was written 15 July, 1771 and probated 17 September 1771 Will Book C-1(1767-1776) page 124-125 naming his loving wife Elizabeth 1/3 of estate to be hers during her natural life and after her decease, to be evenly divided among his ten named children. For those not yet of age, their estates to be left in care of Thomas and James Lewis, sons. Appointed as executors, thomas and James Lewis and Winnifred and wife Elizabeth. Witnesses: Elijah Williams, John Barrett, Sam Weaden.

His children named in will are on Family Group Sheet.

Thomas was a lay reader at Falls Church, Fairfax County, 1759-1760.

James Lewis

1752-1811

He resided in Fairfield and Richland Counties, South Carolina. Listed on 1800 census of Fairfield County, 1 male and 1 female under 10, 1 male and 1 female between 10-16, 2 males and 3 females between 16-26 and wife over 45. He is included in the 1790 and 1810 census of Fairfield County also.

Will Book A page 339 and Will Book C page 185 James Lewis deceased. Appraisal made January 15 1811 by George Hassin, James Hendrix and Elias Hendrix.

Zachariah Lewis bought thread and leather, other purchasers included Joseph Curry, George L. Smith, William Burns, and Minor Gibson. Slae brought 119 pounds 79 shilling and 3 pence sterling.

Camden District Records show that James Lewis and wife Frances formerly Frances Starke of Winnsborough, then in Old Equity District of Camden, were sued by Minor Winn and claimed for the year 1802 Frances had rented ahouse in town of Winnsboro at \$200. and had not paid it and had since married James Lewis. This was tried in April of 1803, jury deciding in her favor and fined Mr. Winn \$40. for false clamor.

There is a few records in Richland County, S.C. Book H pg. 122 to Charles Lewis of Fairfield Co. some land in Fairfield dated 1793 To Thomas Starke of Fairfield Deed Book I page 298 dated January 1794. Probate Office of Richland County Box 66 pkg. 1639 list James Lewis who owned 700 acres on Richland side which was not divided until 11 April 1852, 40 years after his death. At which time his heirs were Elizabeth, Rebecca, Alice, Charity, Sarah, Nancy, Zachariah, James and Surles. All sons were out of state in 1852.

There is only one James Lewis listed in South Carolina, believe Fairfield District, who enlisted 4th Regiment 10 November 1778 as a Matross (?) 1779 under Capt. Richard B. Roberts and re-enlisted 1 January 1780

James Lewis

1781-1842

May 18 1819 James Lewis sold to Thomas McCullough of Fairfield County 107 acres for \$1200. The land was part which was originally granted to John Tidwell on November 19 1772 at Hog Fork on the bank of Wateree Creek in Fairfield District, bounded on north by Thomas McCullough and on north by James Watson, known as the Anthony place. Witness: George P. Combs.. Marisson Graham.

This day Sary Lewis testified as being wife of James Lewis .May 19, 1819

Recorded in Book BB page 216 January 10, 1820 James Lewis and wife Sally of Fairfield District sold to Necky Thomas, for \$1000. all the plantation and tract of land where they resided, being 200 acres situated Fairfield, branch waters of Rocky Creek butting and bounding NE by land owned by William Lewis, east by James Pickett's lane, west by Alexander Rose's land part of 500 acres originally granted to William Sanders in 1772. Sold to Sarah Baker and from her to Moses Paul from him to James Lewis.

This is one reason I believe this could be ours, in that his wife is Sarah/Sally & that they sold this 1820 & were in Tusc. Co. A1 1822
