

Genealogy for Mary Nance Huff from Lyles Ancestors

- Generation No. 1: James Lyles (born about 1660 in England [?]; married Margaret (born about 1662 in England[?]); James died in Henrico County, VA.
- Generation No. 2: John Lyles (born about 1695 in Virginia, died after 1762 in NC)
- Generation No. 3: Ephriam Lyles, Sr. (born about 1720 in Virginia; married Margaret Lyther in 1747; and supposedly killed by Cherokee Indians about 1764)
- Generation No. 4: Arromanus (Col.) Lyles (born about 1748); married Rebecca Valentine about 1774 in Fairfield County, SC
- Generation No. 5: John Lyles 2nd* (born December 25,1776) in Fairfield County; died August 27, 1843, of apoplexy (stroke) or congestive fever; married Mary (Polly) Sims about 1802 in Newberry County, SC, and had five sons and one daughter)
- Generation No. 6: John Valentine Lyles (born April 19, 1816, in Newberry County, SC, and died September 22, 1878, in Maybinton, SC. (He married Rebecca A. Gordon on March 9, 1843. She was born on May 16, 1820, and died between 1866 and 1880.
- Generation No. 7: Eliza Cornelia Ann Elizabeth Lyles (born about 1865 Newberry County; buried at Ebenezer Cemetery in Mabinton, SC.) She married William Nance, who is also buried there.)
- Generation No. 8.: Eugene Sims Nance (born November 20, 1891; died 1957 in Whitmire, SC)
- Generation No. 9: Daphne Leona Nance (born August 30,1913, in Whitmire, SC; died April 2, 2008, in Summerville, SC). She married Atticus Glenn Huff, Jr. in 1938.
- Generation No.10: Mary Nance Huff (born June 2, 1941)

*The oldest son of Ephriam Lyles, Arromanus was the first white child born in what is now known as Fairfield County, South Carolina. His home was Ivey Hall, built between 1790 and 1810. It still stands and has been restored.
