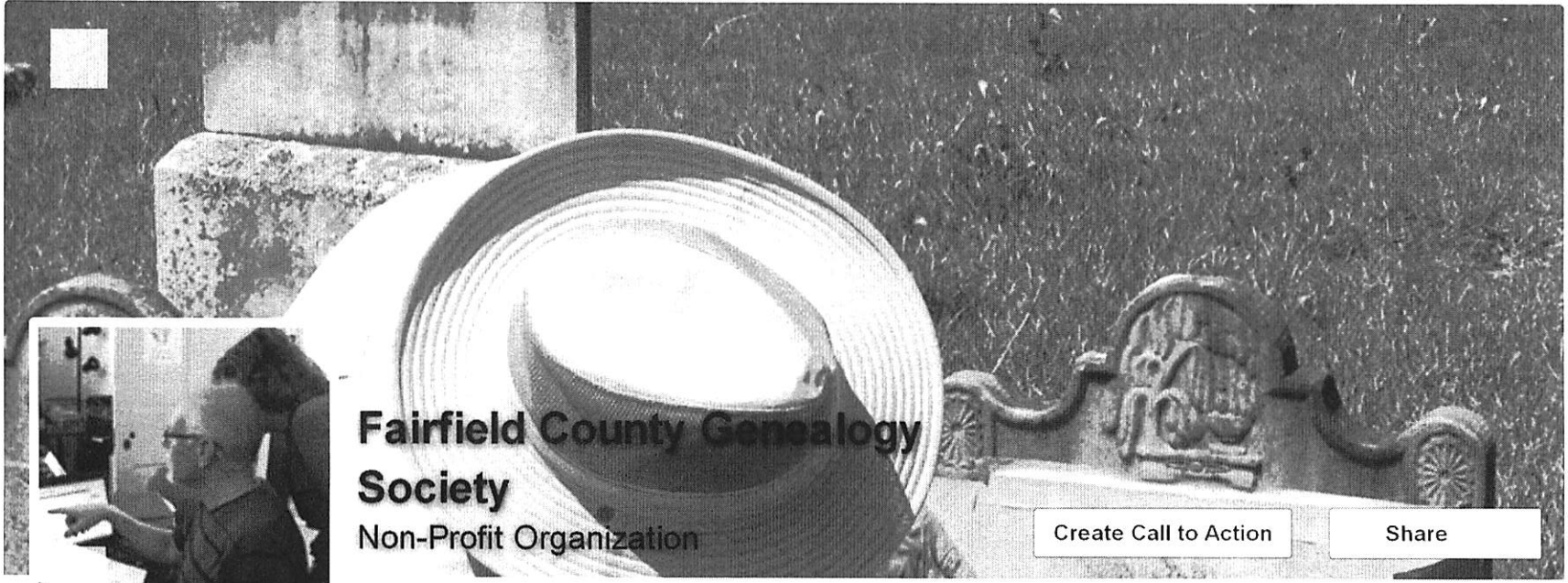

Hello Elizabeth,

Your request is now number #4 of the 22 remaining request.

Thanks for your patience with us. I have been working as time permits on your request the last few days.

Apparently good news, the word must be out about us (see FYI below). However, we are still supplied by a volunteer staff.

As FYI: we use to get on average about 3 request per month, this past year our average was 20 request per month;
our walk-in visitors is up from January 2014, 110, to an average of 139 walk-ins per month in 2014, 226 last month;
out of state visitors is up from January 2014, 2, to an average of 14 out of state visitors per month, 16 last month, 12 today.

We would love to provide our services at no cost and hope to one day be able to provide this service.

However, at this time we are totally supported by volunteers and donations. On our membership application you will see we provide a multiple of research tools and supplies for researchers. We are a 501-C3 society and all donations are tax deductible.

Normally, we encourage researchers to become members of our chapter (see website). Members receive free priority research and free paper copies for their membership year. For non-members, we normally charge \$15 per request (3 hours) and \$.10 per copies.

For our records would you please share any information you have updated on your family lines. The information will be filed and made available in our family files. This will aide to expedite future request for research and assist walk-in researchers.

Please let us know if you need any further assistance and feel free to call us to check the status of your request.

Hey, Can you send more information? Offhand, I can't help you as I do not know of Fannings related to us in the area---yet. Where do you live now? We are planning a Lyles reunion for Oct. 9-10 in Feasterville, an old community in Fairfield County, and hope you can make plans to come meet folks from all numbers of family branches and from all over the US. I don't know of an Asian connection with anyone in this area, although the genetic characteristics should be examined along the paternal side. If you can find a male Lyles descendant from your grandparents, a DNA test might give more information. There are Lyles lines in the Chester area who are showing Native American genetic clues and we also have cousins who are African Americans. A slave Rachel Foote had two children with my great great uncle Belton Lyles in the early 1860s and our Lyles DNA matches as proof. My brother, James M. Lyles, III, has done the DNA for our family and matches with DNA from most descendants of our line who were mainly English from early settlement times along the James River in VA (1600s). The DNA shows haplotypes to trace our prehistoric genetic history through England, Normandy (think, William the Conqueror's invasion), and earlier through southern Norway (think, Viking roots). There is another Lyles line in the south whose DNA identity points back to Irish Celtic roots. Their predecessors came over from Ireland in the late 1600s or early 1700s and migrated south through the Valley of Virginia area (around Staunton) southward to NC and SC from whence the Dave Lyle clan of the Rock Hill area descends. Their DNA does not closely match our line's so it appears they were not related in the old country. The first avenue for you to check information would be to get Helen Fanning's biographical information, dates, family traditions of churches or communities in her background, etc. Also on your g. grandfather and any other predecessors. If you are near Winnsboro, I hope you can come to the museum on a Tuesday through a Friday to do research in our genealogy research room. Eddie Killian, our research room assistant is also a Lyles descendant. If this is impractical, please write to him at fairfieldgenealogy@truvista.net and send the above information for him to start helping you trace your history. A good first start would be to check the US Census records and we have access to all the available ones up to 1940. Many census records have columns for information such as places of birth, etc.

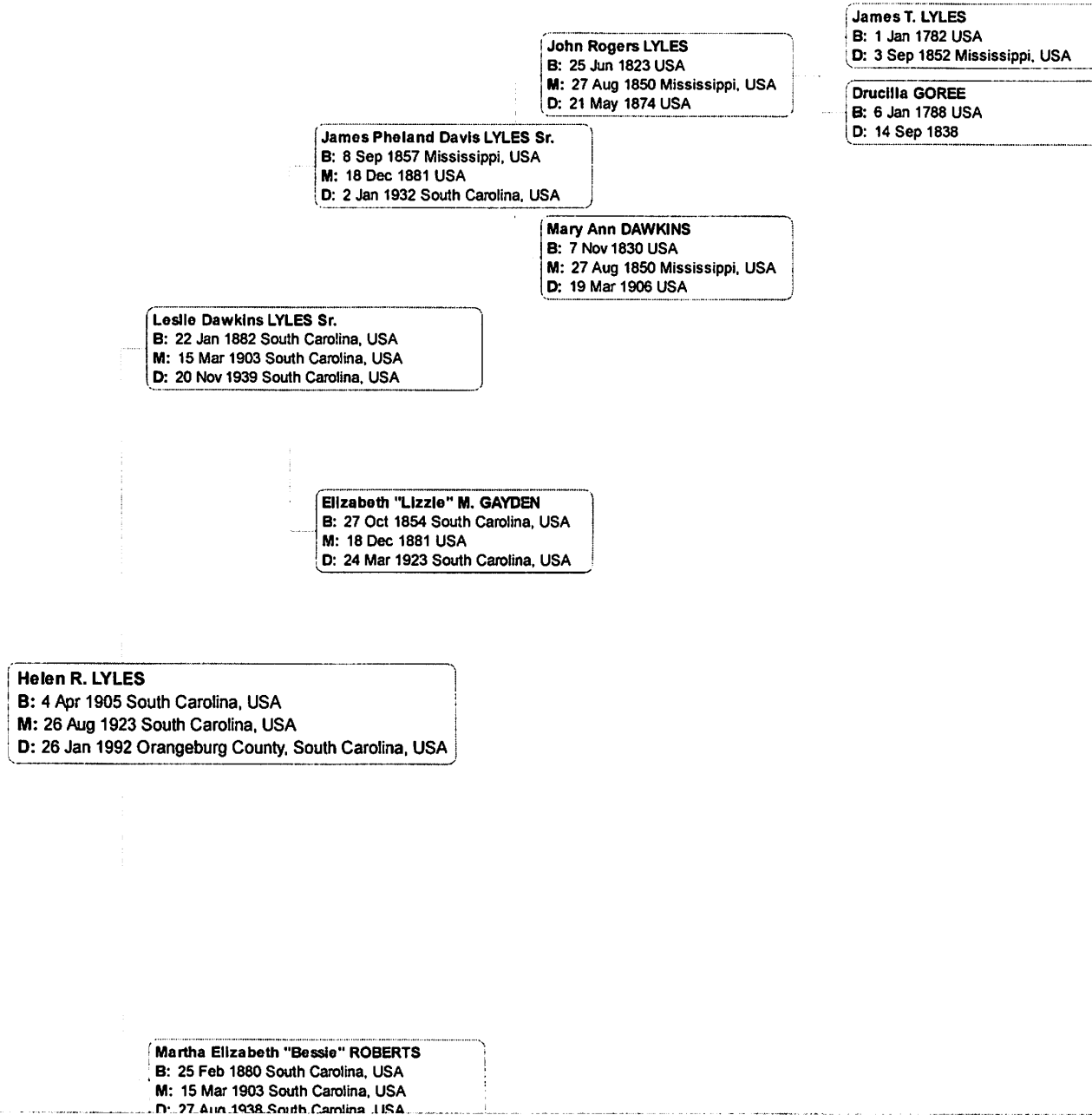


Liles Family Tree

EPHRAIM³ LYLES, SR. (JOHN², JAMES¹) was born Abt. 1720 in Virginia, and died Abt. 1764 in Fairfield Co., S.C. (killed by Indians). He married ANN MARGARET LYTHER Abt. 1747 in Virginia. She was born Abt. 1725 in Virginia, and died Aft. 1762 in Fairfield Co., S.C..

Ephraim, Sr. received a grant for 300 acres in Granville Co., NC in 1742, and sold it in 1755. Acquired 300 acres in present day Fairfield Co., SC, in 1755, and settled on East side of Broad River. Ephraim Lyles (Liles) and two brothers, John and Williamson, migrated from Brunswick, VA. to Fairfield Co., S.C. and settled there around 1745. John was granted land in what is now Newberry Co. Ephraim was supposed to have been killed by Cherokee Indians shortly before 1755, leaving his wife and several children. This is debated, however, some say it was white men dressed as Indians, etc. His estate was probated 1768 at Charleston Co., SC; records at the Columbia SC State Library were processed in 1767 and 1768. Arromanus inherited all his father's property according to the laws of primogeniture. All of Ephraim Sr.'s sons (except Arromanus), settled on the west side (now Newberry Co.) of Broad River. Those sons were: Colonel JAMES Lyles, WILLIAM (Big Bill) Lyles, EPHRAIM (Big Eph) Lyles, HENRY Lyles, and JOHN Lyles. (Source: Annals of Newberry Co., SC, by O'Neall & Chapman)
