




on application its ordered that Jordan Thornton and Parham Mabray be appointed guardians of the persons and property of Ephraim Mabray Elizabeth Mabray and Hilliard Mabray minors and orphans of Adam Mabray dec.<sup>d</sup> and Henry Ware and Edward Lovejoy came into Court and entered themselves Jointly Security in the sum of Eight Thousand dollars for the faithful performance of the above trust.
