(p.266) _____ William Baldwin of the upper parish of Isle of Wight County to Phillis Duce, widow of Surry County, for 200 pounds tobacco.... all of his interest "and right" in 280 acres where said Phillis now liveth on the southwest side of Cypress Swamp. Land is part of a patent for 2600 acres granted said Baldwin and John Duce, late of Surry County, decd., on 20 Apr 1684. Land adjoins Mrs. Mary White. (Elizabeth Baldwin relinquished her Right of Dower.)

(p.267) _____ James Boyce and wife, Elizabeth Boyce, to William Warren for 1680 pounds tobacco.... 300 acres on Indian Spring on the cart path to Mr. Nicholas Meriwether and adjoining Roast Porke Meadow and the Blackwater Road. Land was bought from Capt. Randall.

(p.268) 17 May 1692.... The backside of a Deed of Sale made to Roger Dalks by William Baldwin and John Duce and wife, Phillis Duce, for 490 acres on 3 Mar 1690 shows the acknowledgement.

(p.270) 1 Jul 1692.... William Edwards appoints John Thompson as his attorney in an action against William Miles and Abraham Moore.

(p.271) 17 May 1692.... Bond of Francis Mason, Benjamin Harrison and William Edwards for Francis Mason as High Sheff.

(p.272) 19 Apr 1670.... Thomas Flood to Mr. Nathaniel Knight.... "land left to me by my father Coll. John Flood, Gent." in the upper parish and bounded by Mr. Ford. Thomas Flood is "weake in body".

 NOTE: Below this deed is written that Capt. Thomas Flood, now deceased, sold Nathaniel Knight, also now de cease, land in the upper parish adjoining Mr. Ford. The deed was never recorded and on 5 Nov 1679, Col. William Browne and Mr. Benjamin Harrison as executors of Nathaniel Knight,

(p.69) 10 Sep 1695.... Bond of Willam Browne, Henry Tooker and Walter Flood for William Browne to deliver their parts of the estate of Thomas Jordun, decd., to his orphans, James Jordun and Mary Jordun.

(p.70) 6 Sep 1695.... Sarah Smith appoints Dionisius Wright as her attorney.

(p.70) 29 Oct 1695.... John Reekes replies to the above.

(p.70) 6 Sep 1692.... Robert Nicholson and George Nicholson, executors of George Lee, decd., late of James City to Sarah Lee, widow of said George Lee, decd.... a sum of money, tobacco, goods, etc. and the 100 acres at Chicahominy.

(p.72) 1 Dec 1692.... George Nicholson and wife, Mary Nicholson, of James City County to John Reekes of Martin's Brandon Parish in Charles City County.... rent for 8 years for the water mill bought from Thomas Bird and the adjoining land which was cleared by James Wadkins.

(p.74) 21 Nov 1695.... William Edwards of James City to Thomas Collier of Surry County for 1800 pounds herb and 4770 pounds tobacco.... 500 acres in Southwarke Parish bounded by said Edwards, Francis Sowerby, Mr. John Watkins, the land I bought of Robert Hubbert (Hubbard?) and William Adkinson. Land is part of the land bought from Hubberd and part of a patent I took up when it was deserted by Ralph Creede, decd., and Francis Sowerby, decd. (Ann Edwards, wife of William Edwards, relinquished her Right of Dower.)
