RECORD OF WILLS OF GRANVILLE COUNTY, N. C., ALSO INVENTORIES, ADMINISTRATORS' ACCOUNTS, AND DIVISION OF ESTATES, BOOK 6, 1803-1808

- 1,2- July 20, 1803- proved Aug. Court 1803- JOHN M. PETTWAY wills to his married sisters BETSEY, SALLEY, REBEKAH, and RHODA all the estate I had from my father. divided between them equally; to my brother MARK PETT-WAY and my two single sisters POLLEY and MARTHA PETT-WAY, all the balance of my estate, except such legacies as are hereafter given away, after the payment of my debts; to my friend WILLIAM MURPHY, my chest of carpenter's and joiner's tools with condition that he has no account against me and that he will give to JOSHUA MABRY at the expiration of his apprenticeship 100 dollars worth of carpenter and joiner tools; I wish WIL-LIAM HUNT, at whose house I am, to take into his possession my horse, saddle and bridle, 'Martingale', and collar, my filly and my negro man Bernard and, after advertising for 20 days, sell them to highest bidder and divide money to my brother MARK and single sisters POLLEY and MARTHA PETTWAY; it is my desire that Mr. JAMES LYNE settle the unsettled acct. that is between us and my executors abide by it; Mr. WILLIAM HUNT to pay himself for all his trouble with me, out of my estate that which he believes right. Exrs: WILLIAM HUNT WILLIAM BLACKWELL, and they to collect what due me and pay my debts as well from this estate. Wts: FANNY A. TAYLOR, JANE MITCHELL, LUCY LEWIS.
  - 3- Aug. 6, 1803- WILLIAM HUNT and WILLIAM BLACKWELL render inventory of estate of JOHN M. PETTWAY; mention bond due from JOHN D. HOLCOMB and CHARNAL DURHAM of South Carolina, among other things.
  - 4- Apr. 20, 1793- proved Aug. Court 1803- WILLIAM LOCK wills to son JONATHAN  $147\frac{1}{2}$  acres whereon he lives to wife ELEANOR, plantation whereon I live for her life, with all axes, hoes, and plows; to son STEPHEN, the plantation whereon he lives and the land I left my wife at her death, the two containing  $147\frac{1}{2}$  acres and also the cow and calf he has in his possession; to daughter CATRON, a bed and furniture, a cow and calf;
