DANIEL HARRY

I Daniel Mabry of the State of South Carolina Fairfield district do make and ordain this my last will and Testament. I give and bequeath to Daniel Burns all my right title and interest and inheritance in and to all and singular the tract of Land whereon the said Daniel Burns now lives Containing by a late survey ninety five acres provided the said Daniel Burns shall and does on or before the first day of March next pay to my Executors hereinafter to be named the sum of seventy five dollars. I will that of the ballance of my estate both real and personal do remain in the hands of my wife for the purposes of raising ^{of} my children now with her and payment of my jast debts, at the gathering in of the crops that my Executors do furnish to my said family with a reasonable quantity of provisions for the ensuing year. the ballance if any to be emploid to the payment of my jast debts, and so on yearly in each and every year untill my youngest child Jamina shall arrive to the age of seventeen years which will be in May 1831 then it is my desire said wife Lueasy Mabray do take what will Reasonably satisfy her out of my estate and that Ephraim Mabry and Frances Burns *will reasonably satisfy them then I will that the whole* do likewise take what ^{of} the ballance of my Estate both Real and Personal be equally divided among my children Ally Mabry, Elizabeth Mabry, Mary Mabry, Jofiah Mabry Nancy Mabry, Isaac Mabry, Cisly Mabry, Alfred Mabry and Jarmina Mabry. I will that money be furnisht my Executors to purchase thirty bushells of corn as soon as they can conveniently do it, for the use of my family for the present year and I do hereby also nominate, constitute and appoint my wife Louseasy Mabry then my lawfull Executrix and ledford Nobley and Ephraim my lawfull Executors of t is my last will and Testament in witnefs whereof I do hereunto set my hand and seal this twenty fourth day of March in the year of our Lord 1816--
