In name of God amen the 22nd day of January 1807
 I Mary Mabry of South Carolina Fairfield district Being
 very sick and Weak in body but of Perfect mind and Memory
 thanks be given Unto God therefore Calling to mind the
 Mortality of my Body and knowing that it is appointed
 for all men once to die do make And ordain this my Last
 will and Testament that is to Say Principally and first
 of all I Give and Recommend my Soul Into the hands of
 almighty God who gave it and my Body I Recommend to the
 Earth to be burried In Decent Christian burral at the
 Discretion of my Executors nothing doubting but at the
 Resurrection of the dead I Shall Receive the Same again
 by the mighty power of God and as toching such Worldly
 affairs or Estate here with It has pleased God to Bless
 me in this Life I give devise and Dispose of the Same In
 the following manner and form I give and Bequath to
 Daniel Mabry my welbeloved Son fifty Dollars to be Raised
 and Levied out of My Estate with all he has formally had
 of My Estate in his hands I also Give and bequath to my
 well beloved Daughter Mary Mobley three Hundred and fifty
 dollars to be Raised and Levied out of My Estate I also
 give and bequath Ephraim Mabry my well beloved son two
 Negroes Pompey and ally by name also one Feather bed and
 Furniture one Cow and Calf also all and Singular my lands
 Misenages and tenements by him freely to be Pofessed and
 Enjoyed I also give and bequath to my other well beloved
 Sons and Daughter namely Joel Mabi Susanny Moorman Seisily
 Wager Marget W Mabry adam Mabry Elizabeth- Poole all and
 Entirely the Balance of my Estate Real or personal to be Equal-
 ly parted or administered to each one I also make and
 ordain Daniel Mabry afore said My Sole Executor to my last
 will and Testament to perform this administration of my
 Estate and I do hereby utterly Disallow Revok and Disannul
 all
 Turn over
 And Every other former testaments wills legasels and

bequeste And Executors by me in any wise before mentioned
willed and bequeathed Ratyfing and Confirming this and no
other to be my last will and testament In Witnen whereof I
have here unto at my hand and Seal this 22nd Day Jany In
the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and Seven

and Declared by the Saidxxxxx Mary
