Gideon Maccon, French Huguenot, bor in France 1650, comes to Virginia 1680, mar. Martha Woodward. Resided Middle Plantation (Williamsburg) Virginia.
Their dau. Martha Maccon married Orlando Jones, first Rector Bruton Parish Church. She is buried in the chancel of church.

GIDEON MACON I

Gideon Macon, born in France 1650 came to Virginia 1680. Resided Middle Plantation, Virginia. (Williamsburg)

Member of Burgessess from 1693 to 1698.

Son of Sir Jacques Macon. The Macon family originated in Frances's Senna et Loire County. Capital Macon.

Jousserand de Macon, knighted in 1321. His son was Louis de Macon, whose son was Gabriel de Macon.

GIDEON MACON II

Said Gideon Macon II 1682-1751 left eight children, among them the wives of Col. John Hawkins, Col. John Alston, and a son, John Macon, whom many believe the was equal of Nathaniel. In 1763 his widow married James Hanson.

WILLIAM JOHN MARTIN

Said Wm. John Martin I, a planter of Granville County, N. C. came from England first half of the eighteenth century. He married Ann Long, daughter of Col. Nicholas Long, Halifax, N. C. Col. Long, member of Provincial Congress 1774. Member safety 1775. Col. Minute Man, Quartermaster General 1775. Besides his son, Wm. John Martin II, who married Betsy Kemp Macon, he left three daughters. One married Richard Bullock, one married Col. Henry Lyne, son of Wm. Lyne, Burgess, and one married Kemp Plummer, brother of Hannah Plummer, who married Nathaniel Macon.

Said Hannah Plummer, wife of Nathaniel Macon, daughter of Capt. Wm. Plummer II, Planter, Gloucester County, Va., near Lobjack Bay, and Mary Hayes Reynolds. He was vestryman of Kingstons Parrish. Capt. of Gloucester Co. in American Revolution.

Said Wm. Plummer II, son of Wm. Plummer I, Planter Middlesex County, Va., original patentee of land at head of Ducking Pond Creek, and his wife, Betsy Kemp, daughter of Mathew Kemp, Burgess 1685. Wm. Plummer I, born in England, emigrated to Va. early part of 18th century, ca 1717 D 1779. Revolutionary Records, ref. ab com an genl. N. C. records.

William John Martin departed this life at the same place on Dec. 11th 1828.

Ann Maria Marrow departed this life at the residence of her husband,

Drury B. Marrow, in Granville Co., N.C. on the 4th of June 1833.

Hannah P. Williams died at Edgcomb, 1852.

Robt. A. Martin and Ann E. McIlwaine were married the 21st of May 1842.

Ann E. McIlwaine was born Sept., 13th 1830. She was the daughter of A. G. McIlwaine, whose father was Richd. McIlwaine. Her mother was Martha Dunn, whose father was Robt. Dunn. Mrs. McIlwaine's mother was Ann Strawbridge.

Mr. A. G. McIlwaine's mother was Jane Graham.

All of the above except Robt. A. Martin and Ann E. McIlwaine were Irish by birth.
