

*Crossing the Bar*

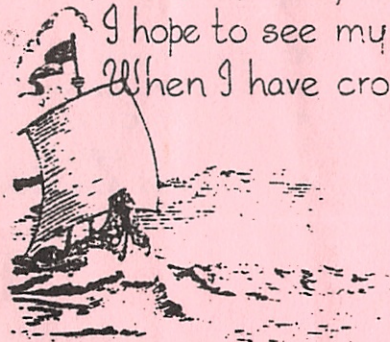
**S**unset and evening star,

When I have crossed the bar.

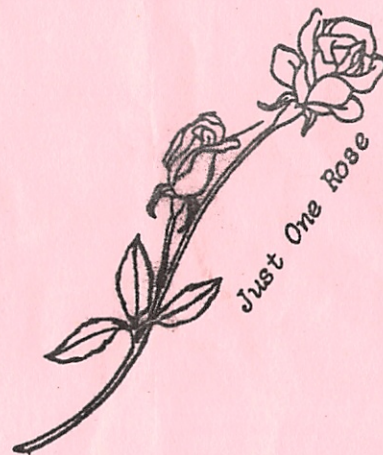
