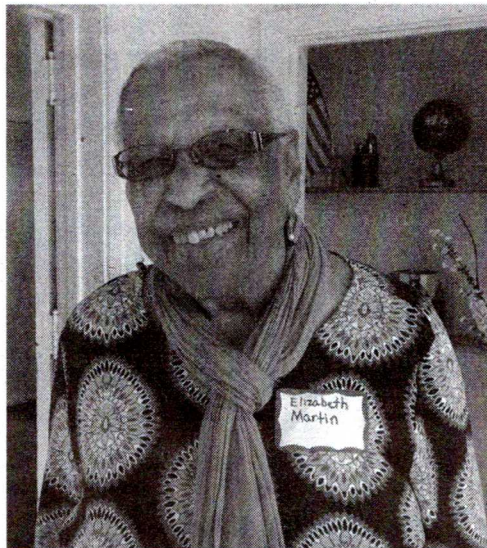


Senior Spotlight
