Cooper, on the 21 day of April, 1861, and served in that command until the 21 day of April, 1861. He was discharged from the service at Grantsboro on the 21 day of April, 1861, and was at that time a member of Company 1, Regiment of Palmetto, Captain H. C. Cooper. I was married to him 1861 on the 21 day of April, 1861. My husband did not desert the service of the Confederate States nor of this State. My husband died on the 21 day of April, 1861. My income from all sources does not exceed \$500.00—does not exceed \$4,000.00. The valuation of all my property does not exceed \$500.00—does not exceed \$1,000.00. I am 65 years of age. I reside Frankfield, S.C. in Frankfield County, S. C. and have lived there since the 21 day of April, 1861.

I have not been on the pension roll of South Carolina, nor any other State, nor of the United States.
