

## McClintock: Coat of Arms.

Arms - per pale fules and argent, a chevron ermine between 3 escallops counterchanged.

Crest - a Lion passant gules

Motto - Virtute et labore. (By Valor & Labor)

### Symbolism.

Gules (red) - Military fortitude.

Argent (silver) - Peace & sincerity.

Ermine (a fur) - Is a bearing of great dignity and honor and has long been associated with the robes and crowns of royal and distinguished persons.

An escallop shell shows that the granter of the arms or an ancestor was one of those who journeyed to the Holy Sepulchre as a Palmer or Mendicant Friar. The Chevron represents the rafters of the house and stands for protection.

The lion is the emblem of undaunted and undying courage.
