

- 31, 561: Benjamin Mazyck, 1250 acres in Ninety Six District on Little Saludy River adj. Thomas Clark, Mason Izard, Thomas Berry, Jacob Berry deceased, William Jones, James Davis, Arthur Simpkin, Lewis Peterman, 26 July 1774. Plat certified 18 March 1773.
