HONORED LADY NINA STEVENSON McCLINTOCK WATSON

AROUND HIGH NOON, JANUARY 2, 1994, OUR HEAVENLY FATHER CALLED HONORED LADY NINA STEVENSON McCLINTOCK WATSON HOME. SHE SLIPPED QUIETLY AWAY. "WELL DONE THOU GOOD AND FAITHFUL SERVANT, ENTER THOU INTO THE JOY OF THE LORD".

H.L. NINA WAS BORN IN FAIRFIELD COUNTY, THE DAUGHTER OF THE LATE DAVID LEE AND ANNA TURNER STEVENSON. AFTER ATTENDING MT. ZION INSTITUTE AND ERSKINE COLLEGE, SHE MARRIED THE LATE JAMES AIKEN McCLINTOCK, WHO PREDECEASED HER IN 1965. FROM THIS UNION, THEIR ONLY SON, JAMES AIKEN McCLINTOCK, JR., WAS KILLED IN ACTION, SEPT. 21, 1944. SHE HAD FOUR LOVELY DAUGHTERS, WHO CARED FOR HER IN LATER YEARS, H.L. MARGIE SHEALY, ANNE FRITZ, RUTH PRICE OF COLUMBIA AND TILLIE ROBERTS OF CHESTER.

DURING HER YOUNGER YEARS SHE WAS ACTIVE IN LEBANON PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH AND FAIRFIELD COUNTY COMMUNITY AFFAIRS. SINCE 1954 SHE HAS BEEN A RESIDENT OF THE ST. ANDREWS COMMUNITY IN COLUMBIA. IN 1967 SHE MARRIED P.E. WATSON, SR., WHO PASSED AWAY IN 1974.

H.L. NINA WAS A FAITHFUL MEMBER OF MAGNOLIA COURT #5, ORDER OF THE AMARANTH, AS LONG AS HER HEALTH PERMITTED. SHE WAS A LOVELY LADY, ALWAYS CHEERFUL AND MEETING EACH ONE WITH A SMILE.

SHE WAS A MEMBER OF COLUMBIA SHRINE #6, ORDER OF THE WHITE SHRINE OF JERUSALEM. SHE WAS ALWAYS HAPPY TO MEET EACH ONE AND WAS AN INSPIRATION TO ALL THAT KNEW HER.

SHE WAS A MEMBER OF ST. ANDREWS PARK SENIOR CITIZENS, VFW AUXILIARY 641, WORLD WAR I AUXILIARY, SOUTHERN RAILROAD RETIREMENT CLUB AND THE GOLD STAR MOTHERS.

AT THE TIME OF HER DEATH, SHE WAS A MEMBER OF ST. ANDREWS LUTHERAN CHURCH AND THE MANGRUM CIRCLE.

WE SHARE IN THE LOSS OF A GREAT FRIEND AND LOVED ONE; WE MOURN HER PASSING.

WE LIVE KNOWING THAT EACH DAY IS A GIFT FROM GOD AND ONE DAY WE TOO WILL LEAVE THIS LIFE TO JOIN HER IN A PLACE THAT IS FAR BETTER THAN ANYTHING WE HAVE KNOWN HERE.

H.L. NINA WAS PART OF OUR LIVES; HER FRIENDLY ATTITUDE, HER ABILITY TO LAUGH AT HERSELF AND LIFE AND HER COMFORTABLE MANNER HAS TOUCHED EACH OF US.

SERVICES WERE HELD IN ST. ANDREWS LUTHERAN CHURCH, FEBRUARY 1, 1994, BURIAL IN LEBANON PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH CEMETARY, WINNSBORO S.C.

WE SHARE IN THIS GREAT LOSS OF A MOTHER AND FRIEND.. IT IS IN DYING THAT WE ARE BORN TO "ETERNAL LIFE";WITH SADDENED HEARTS WE EXTEND TO HER FAMILY, UNDERSTANDING SYMPATHY AND PRAYERS.
