This census states that Reed and Maggie had been married 25 years and Maggie had 9 children and all 9 were still living.

**Sallie McConnell** – cannot find any record of children

Sallie's death certificate states:

Born in 1880 in Fairfield County and died on December 7, 1960 in Columbia

She was a widow and her husband was Mack Jester

Daughter of Reed McConnell and Majorie Jetter

She is buried in the McConnell Family Cemetery in Shelton Section of Fairfield County, her tombstone has these dates – born February 6, 1880 – died December 7, 1960

**Virgil McConnell** – cannot find any record of children

He is buried in the McConnell Family Cemetery

Tombstone has him born on April 5, 1883 and died on August 10, 1931

Virgil McConnell was living in Manhattan, New York, NY in the 1920 Census – he was 36 and living with his wife Amelia, no children listed

**Andy Mack McConnell** – single and had no children

From Death Certificate:

Was single-born on June 2, 1886 and died on October 9, 1918, son of Reed McConnell and Margie Jeter

Buried in the McConnell Family Cemetery

**Hunley McConnell** – cannot find any records of children

Buried in the McConnell Family Cemetery – born 1886 and died April 8, 1918

His death Certificate states that he was born on April 7, 1886 and died on April 5, 1918, married and son of Reed McConnell and Margie Jeter, he was buried in the Elizabeth Cemetery – he is buried in the McConnell Family Cemetery which is just across the road from th Elizabeth Cemetery

Lidia in on stone with him-probably his wife – August 29, 1890 – December 1912

**Hattie McConnell** – had no children

Buried in the McConnell Family Cemetery – May 6, 1892 – June 9, 1907

**Lorenzo McConnell** – cannot find any records of children

New York Death Certificate

Born on November 10, 1889 in South Carolina, died on May 27, 1946 in Manhattan, New York City, NY,

Buried in the Reed Cemetery in Shelton, SC, he was widowed (think he is buried in an unmarked grave in the McConnell Family Cemetery)

He married Anna L. Skillman on April 14, 1916, son of Reed McConnell and Maggie Jetter, it was his first marriage and her second.

He married Hattie Niureland Elliott on September 30, 1925 in Manhattan, New York City, NY

The 1920 Census lists him living in Westchester and the head of the household, he was listed as married but the only two people living in the house with him were two boarders, his wife was not listed.

The 1940 Census has him living in Manhattan, New York City, NY, and was lodger living with Annie Williams and was widowed.
