**MRS. NANNIE CORLEY**  
**RETIRED TEACHER DIES**  
Mrs. Nannie McCrorey Corley of 1005 Beatties Ford Road died Sunday, March 6, 1966, at the home of her son, William Henry Corley, 1900 Northbrook Drive after a brief illness. Mrs. Corley, the daughter of the late Henry and Nancy McCrorey, was born in Fairfield County, South Carolina. She was the sister of the late Dr. Henry Lawrence McCrorey, a former president of Johnson C. Smith University. Her early education was completed at Brainard Institute and Harbison Institute. She then entered Johnson C. Smith University and continued there until she had completed work for the A.B. degree. She was united in marriage to the late Rev. Angus Patterson Corley. To this union two sons were born, Angus Patterson and William Henry. She dedicated her life and services to Christian work. After moving to Charlotte, she joined the Biddleville Presbyterian Church of which she remained a member until 1935. She then joined the Brandon Presbyterian Church of which her husband was pastor. This membership she held until her death. She taught in the public schools of Chester County, South Carolina and the Mecklenburg County Schools for 20 years. She retired in 1948. Mrs. Corley was a former member of the Mecklenburg County Teachers Association, a member of the Priscilla Art and Literary Club and Missionary Circle #3, United Women's Organization of Brandon Presbyterian Church. She is survived by her son, William Henry Corley of Charlotte; three grandchildren, Miss Marsha Nannette Corley of Washington, D. C., Angus McCrorey Corley and Ronald Corley of White Plains, New York; a number of nieces, nephews, other relatives and friends. Funeral services will be held Wednesday, 3:30 p.m., at Brandon Presbyterian Church with Rev. Raymond Worsley officiating. Dr. Thomas Jenkins will deliver the eulogy. Interment will be in the North Pine-wood Cemetery. The body will lie in state at Brandon Presbyterian Church, Wednesday, from 12:00 noon until the hour of the service. The family will receive friends at 1900 Northbrook Drive, Northwood Estates.
