Sealed with our seals, and dated the *eighteenth* day of *April*in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and *Twenty***THE Condition of the above Obligation is such,**That if the above bound *Ephraim Lyles*Administrator of the goods, chattels and credits of *Joseph M'Parrell*

deceased, do make a true and perfect inventory of all and singular the goods, chattels and credits of the said deceased, which have or shall come to the hands, possession or knowledge of the said

*Ephraim Lyles*or into the hands or possession of any other person or persons for *him* and the same so made, do exhibit into the said Court of Ordinary, when *he* shall be thereunto required, and such goods,

chattels and credits do well and truly administer according to law, and do make a just and true account of his actings and doings therein when required by the said Court, and all the rest of the said goods, chattels and credits which shall be found remaining upon the account of the said administration, the same being first allowed by the said Court, shall deliver and pay unto such persons respectively as are entitled to the same by law, and if it shall hereafter appear that any last will and testament was made by the said deceased, and the same be proved in Court, and the Executors obtain a certificate of the probate thereof,
