1749. John McKeamy, Augusta Co., Va., deed from Jane Downs. 1750. William McAmy, Hanover Township, Lancaster, Pa., land survey, 100 acres, not patented.

1751. William McCamish, Hamilton Township, Cumberland Co., Pa., 200 acres surveyed. 1754. John McCamy, Lurgan Township, Cumberland Co., Pa., 50 acres surveyed.

1758. Francis McKaimy, Orange Co., N.C., born Aug. 15, moved to Guilford Co. about 1780-90.

176l. Jane McKamie Cunningham, nr. Williamsburg, Va., executor of husband's will, Sam Cunningham, along with brother, John McKamie.
