THE MINCEY FAMILY

My research traces the Mincey family from their settlement in Georgia in 1765 to the present day, over two hundred years.

The education and accomplishments of the descendants can be recorded and published by the individual families, if so desired.

The book I am compiling here is only a genealogical record.

My book is lovingly dedicated to my mother, Christina May Speth, the youngest child of Celia Anne Mincey Patterson May, and also to John Leon Mincey, the youngest child of my great grandfather, Abraham Mincey and Talulah Emma Dugger.

MY SEARCH BEGINS

In 1962 I wrote to Mr. Clyde Hollingsworth, retired postmaster and genealogist, of Sylvania, Georgia, in Screven County.

Mr. Hollingsworth sent me the following record of the Mincey family, which I had requested. This record was just enough to stir my interest and desire to pursue the family tree.

MINCEY FAMILY RECORDS

Abraham and Patience (Daughtry?) Mincey settled in Saint Matthews Parish, new Screven County, Georgia in 1770. It is known that he had one son, Shadrick Mincey (Book "A" page 369, clerk records of Screven County. It is not known who Shadrick married. He had one son, John Mincey (Book "A", page 369).

John Mincey married Ceely Hendrix (Hendricks) of Screven County, (Book P, page 78, clerk's office, Screven County). Children of John and Ceely or Celia Hendricks Mincey were:

1. Celia Mincey, no record.
2. Shadrick Mincey, who married Mary Waters.
3. Elizabeth Mincey, who married David Hendrix.
4. Abraham Mincey, who married Elizabeth Moore, Dec. 22, 1834.
5. William Mincey, bachelor.
6. Martha Mincey, who married Thomas Ellis.
7. Clara Mincey, who married Lemuel Parker.

Children of Abraham Mincey and Elizabeth Moore were:

- James Mincey
- David Mincey
- Washington Mincey
- Henry Mincey
- Cecelia Mincey
- Augustus Mincey.

There is no record of the parentage of Elizabeth Moore.

In the Screven County census of 1830, John Moore, Sr. is shown as a neighbor of the Hendrix and Minceys.

This road was established pursuant to an act passed by
the Colonial Assembly, April 2, 1770.

It connected the early settlement of Greensboro, at the
head of Ogeechee River Navigation with Savannah.

It became one of the most important Stages and Post
Routes in the State, when Louisville was Capitol.

On September 16, 1777 the State of Assembly, named
the first board of commissioners for its (?) maintenance.

P., St. George's Parish.

(Page 375) Christian Bell of St. Matthews Parish, widow, to Thomas Chisam of same parish, gentleman. Deed dated May 23, 1772, conveys 300 acres in Parish of St. George, granted grantor December 3, 1771. Witnesses: William Johnson, Edward Botsford, Isaac Mounsey. Probated by the latter before John A. Trustlin, J.P.

(Page 377) Thomas Chisholm, Esq., of St. Matthews Parish, to John Minzies of Savannah. Deed dated November 25, 1774, conveys the above 300 acres. Witnesses: Joseph Pannell, John Milton and Joseph Goldwire. Probated by the latter before Thomas Hoodie, J.P., Christ Church Parish.

The Landmark at Rockyford reads:

First County Seat

Between 1765 and 1770 a group of Settlers mostly from North Carolina settled and received grants for land in the vicinity of what is now Rockyford. Among these settlers were: Benjamin Lanier, Lemuel Lanier, Valentine Hollingsworth, Francis Jones, Thomas Mills, Anthony Bonnell, *Abraham Mincey, Robert Dixon and Michael Dixon.

The first county seat of Scriven County was established here, on December 14, 1793. And the home of Benjamin Lanier across miles branch from this marker was the first county court house(124-1).

Abraham and Patience (Daughtry?) Mincey settled in Saint Matthews Parish, now Screven County, Georgia in 1770. It is known that he had one son, Shadrick Mincey (Book "A" page 369, Clerk records of Screven County. It is not known who Shadrick married. He had one son, John Mincey (Book "A", Page 389) John Mincey married Geely Hendrix (Hendricks) of Screven County. (Book P. Page 78, Clerk's Office, Screven County)

THE MINCEY FAMILY
of
SCREVEN COUNTY.

Abraham Mincey, the progenitor of the Mincey family of Screven County, Georgia, and his wife, Patience, settled in Saint Mathews Parish about 1770. Abraham was granted, by the King of England, 200 acres of land in what is now known as Rockyford, Georgia. The exact date of the grant can not be ascertained as many of the old land grant records of colonial Georgia have been lost. Between 1765 and 1770 a number of families from Duplin County, North Carolina settled in the vicinity of Rocky Ford, and since Abraham Mincey's land joined that of these early settlers it can be assumed that he settled about the same time and possibly came from the same county in North Carolina.

Among the neighbors of Abraham Mincey were, Benjamin Lanier, Lemuel Lanier, Valentine Hollingsworth, Thomas Mills, Luke Mizell, William Blackburn, Anthony Bonnell, Francis Jones, Robert Dixon, Michael Dixon and others. Mincey's land joined Benjamin Lanier and his son, Clement's. The Lanier's land was located on Mile Branch in what is now Rocky Ford. Just before Abraham Mincey died, in about 1800, he sold to Lewis Lanier 450 acres of land (See Book "I", page 8, Clerk's Office, Screven County, dated 12-6-1798) which was described as being located on both sides of Horse Creek, near the mouth of said creek. He later sold to Lewis Lanier 73 acres that lay between the Ogeechee River and the above 450 acres (See same book page 9.) The

Mincey land can definitely be placed as lying between the present town of Rocky Ford and the Ogeechee River with most of the town probably being on land formerly owned by Mincey.

The earliest record we have of Abraham Mincey is that of September 18th, 1777, when he, along with Robert Dixon, Thomas Mills, William Blackburn, and John Mizell were named Commissioners of the old road established in 1770 (Now the Louisville road) north of the Ogeechee River. They were named Commissioners by a legislative act of the Georgia Assembly. His large land holdings is indicative that he was a thrifty business man, and his selection as a Commissioner by the Legislature indicates that he was well known and of good repute among the people of then East Georgia.

In 1793 Abraham's health apparently caused him to dispose of most of his property for he died before November 2nd, 1801. On this date Patience Mincey sold some land and only her name was affixed to the deed. If her husband had been living, he too, would have had to sign. At that time only unmarried women could own property in the own right in Georgia. Between November 2nd, 1801 and December 28th, 1803, the widow, Patience, married Luke Mizell.

So far as the records disclose only one son was born to Abraham and Patience Mincey. Jacob Mincey lived in Rocky Ford at this time, and was, no doubt, either a son or brother of Abraham. The one known son of Abraham and Patience was, Shadrick (or Shadrick). Shadrick was the first Mincey of that given name in Georgia. Shadrick died very young,

leaving only one son, John. This record is found in Book "A", page 369, the record of a deed given by Luke and Patience Kizell, "In consideration of the love and good will which we have and do bear toward John Minsey, son of Shadrick Minsey, deceased, and grandson of said Patience Minsey". At the time of the signing of this instrument, December 28, 1803, John Minsey was a minor. The land given to John was described as being on Donnell Branch. Shadrick Minsey lived during the time of which many of the county records were subsequently destroyed. Other than the brief reference to him in the above mentioned deed not anything is recorded.

John Minsey, son of Shadrick, lived during the prosperous slave era of Surren County. The record indicates that he was a man of means. There is no record of his marriage, or as for that matter of anyone that may have been married previous to 1833. Fortunately, there is a record of the settlement of his estate, and from its division we learn much of the Minsey family. He died in 1833 at a mature age. All of his children then living were married or of a marriageable age. ~~John~~ Minsey, a son of John, and Lemuel Parker, a son-in-law, were administrators of the estate. The estate records disclose that at the time of his death he owned six slaves valued at \$1000.00 to \$1500.00 each. His furniture was of the period and included one loom with attachments and one spinning wheel with attachments. One entry of the expenditures of the Administrators was the payment of \$4.00 to W. T. Opie for building a coffin.

At the time of the death of John Kinsey he had the following living children: Callie Kinsey, a spinster; Elizabeth Kinsey; Mary Kinsey, who married Thomas Dabney; Elizabeth Kinsey, who married David Embling; Abraham Kinsey, who married Elizabeth Moore, December 12, 1833; William Kinsey Kinsey, a bachelor; Martha Kinsey, who married Thomas Ellis; and Glary Kinsey, who married Lemuel Foster, February 9th, 1834. Of the above children, Elizabeth Kinsey is the progenitor of practically all of the people of that name in Sevier County, and unfortunately there is no record of his marriage in this county. The census record of 1830 gives his wife's name as Mary. However family records are that she was Mary Waters.

Elizabeth and Mary Waters Kinsey were the parents of ten children: (1) Hannah (Kinsey) Brown. According to the records in the Ordinary's Office Hannah married Daniel H. Brown, January 13th, 1834, however the family record is Brown. It is possible that in transferring from the wedding certificate to the record a mistake could have been made in the spelling of the name. (2) Virginia (Kinsey) Day; (3) Betty (Kinsey) McKinney, who married William H. McKinney; (4) John Marshall Kinsey, who married (2-27-39) Barbara Florence Caddoge who was the daughter of John Allen Weston Caddoge and Mary Ann (James) Caddoge; (5) James Marion Kinsey, who married Emily Emphalee (1-10-40); (6) Ephraim Kinsey, who married William Hunt; (7) Melvin Kinsey, who married John Roberts; (8) Callie Kinsey of whom there is no record; (9) David Lafayette Kinsey, who married Amanda Moore; and (10) James Joshua Kinsey, who

married first (12-17-1877) Mary Brown and second Maggie Brown.

THE MINCEY FAMILY OF SCREVEN COUNTY , GEORGIA

Abraham Mincey, the progenitor of the Mincey family of Screven County, Georgia, and his wife, Patience daughter of Michael Daughtrey, settled in St. Matthew Parish 1765-1770 along with others from Duplin County, North Carolina. They were: Benjamin Lanier, Lemuel Lanier, Valentine Hollingsworth, Thomas Mills, Luke Mizell, William Blackburn, Anthony Bonnell, Francis Jones, Robert Dixon, Michael Dixon, and others. The area in which they settled is in vicinity of Rocky Ford, Georgia. The Lanier land was located on Mile Branch and lands of Abraham Mincey bordered on Lanier's. Abraham asked for a grant of land in March 1771 stating he had a wife and one child, 200 acres was surveyed to him in 1772 at St. Matthew Parish (now Screven Co.). The record of this transaction is listed in The Headrights and Bounty Grants of Georgia (Bk. I, pge. 708). The description of this grant shows it was bordered by vacant land, lands of Benjamin and Clement Lanier, and lands of Abraham Mincey's. It would seem that he had bought land before asking for this grant as he later (1788) sold 100 acres that had been granted to William Colson in 1769. There are other land records concerning Abraham Mincey in Screven and Effingham Counties. By 1782 his lands had been confiscated and he was at St. Augustine, Florida with many other Loyalists. After the war he returned to the area and had his rights restored to him by Georgia Legislature, he proceeded to buy more land after that.

In October 1799, Patience Mincey, widow of Abraham Mincey, deceased, applied for dismissal of her administration of the estate. Prior to Abraham's death he sold several tracts of land, and Patience sold some after his death, therefore he had rather large land holdings. In 1797 Abraham and Patience sold to Wes Woodward. In 1798 he sold to Lewis Lanier 450 acres on both sides of Horse Creek (Bk. I, p.8) and then sold Lanier another 76 acres that lay between the Ogeechee River and the above 450 acres (Bk. I, p. 9). In 1801 the widow Patience sold 183 acres to John Moore. These records are in the Clerk's Office in Screven County. Sometime between 2 November 1801 and 28 December 1803 the widow Patience married Luke Mizell. The proof for this lies in a deed dated 1801 and signed by Luke and Susannah Mizell (she was nee Susannah (Jones) Dixon), and a deed dated 1803 "Luke and Patience Mizell to John Mincey, son of Shadrick Mincey and grandson of Patience".

Shadrick Mincey is the only documented child of Abraham and Patience. Shadrick married before 1789 Jane (___ ?), had son John born that year, and were divorced in 1795. The last mention of Shadrick is as witness to a deed 6 Dec. 1798.

It is assumed that Shadrick Mincey was dead before December 1803 when his mother, Patience, and her new husband, Luke Mizell, deeded land (200 acres on Bonnell's Branch) to Shadrick's son John "in trust until he reached age 21" making themselves the trustees. No further records have been found for Jane, wife of Shadrick.

One other record concerning Abraham Mincey was when he, Robert Dixon, Thomas Mills, William Blackburn, and John Mizell were named Commissioners of the old road (established in 1770 and now the Louisville Road). They were named Commissioners by a Legislative Act of the Georgia Assembly on 16 September 1777. Abraham's selection as a Commissioner indicates that he was well known and of good repute among the people of his county. His large land holdings indicate that he was a thrifty business man.

John Mincey, born 1789, son of Shadrick and Jane, lived during the prosperous slave era of Screven County and records show that he was a man of means. No marriage records exist prior to 1833 so we must rely on censuses and the estate settlement in 1860 for proof of his marriage and children. John married Celia Hendricks, daughter of John Hendricks, Revolutionary War soldier, and Mary Tallant. At the time of John's death all of his children living were married or of marriageable age. On 1 Sept. 1860 his sons, Shadrick and Abraham Mincey were named administrators of John's estate (Bk.C, p. 113) and on 10 Sept. 1860 the administrator's bond was signed by Shadrick Mincey, Abram Mincey, Lemuel Parker, Edmond B. Gross, David Hendricks, Matthew Parker, James Parker, and Henry Parker. Then on 14 Nov. 1860 Celia Mincey, Thos. Beasley, and Shadrick Mincey, as heirs and executor, signed for the appointment of Celia (the widow of John) as guardian of William Mincey, and Idiot (Bk. 9-A, p. 114). Estate records show that, at his death, John owned six slaves valued at \$1000.00 to \$1500.00 each, his furniture was of the period, including one loom with attachments and one spinning wheel with attachments. One entry of the expenditures was payment to W.T. Opie for building a coffin. In 1860 John and Celia had the following eight children:

The children of John and Celia (Hendricks) Mincey are listed on the following pages. They are listed in same sequence as the lineup on page 2 with the exception of child # 5, Abraham Mincey m. Elizabeth Moore(they are filed last).

Abraham Mincey was married twice and had children from both marriages. He is the ancestor of Dorothy M. Perry through the first wife. Three Family Group Sheets, numbered 6, 6a, and 6b, show Abraham's family through both marriages.

The children listed on page 2 are not lined up according to the year of birth, but that sequence has been adhered to in the following pages to make it easier for the reader to follow each child.



THE BULLOCK COUNTY MINCEYS

Abraham Mincey, my great grandfather, was born September 30, 1817. He was a highly respected man in Bullock County, Georgia. He was the first paymaster on the Central of Georgia Railroad. He was ambitious and acquired much land which is evidenced by the many deeds concerning his possessions. He was considered a good business man. He was a farmer by trade and devoted his life to his family.

My mother told me of the stories she was told about Abraham, her grandfather. He was known to be a very kind and honest man. One time the story goes that he was ill in bed when Sherman was on his March through Georgia. Sherman's soldiers came to his home and demanded food. The Yankee soldiers threw Abraham off his bed onto the floor, then out into the yard. They then ransacked the house, taking all possessions and food.

Abraham had five sons who fought in the War Between the States: Augustus, John Jackson, William Washington, James Marion, and Jordan. The military records of these loyal volunteers are in the Archives in Atlanta, Georgia.

Abraham was tall of stature, a lanky type similar in physique to Abraham Lincoln. He had very fair complexion and steel blue, blue eyes. I have met several Minceys in the past sixteen years and all had similar physical appearances: John Leon Mincey in Savannah, Georgia, Austin Upshaw Mincey at Portal, Georgia, Zachariah Mincey in Baxley, Georgia, Annie Mincey Womack in Atlanta, Georgia, and Ollie Mincey Northcut in Folly Beach, Georgia.

I feel we owe much to our heritage from this fine man.

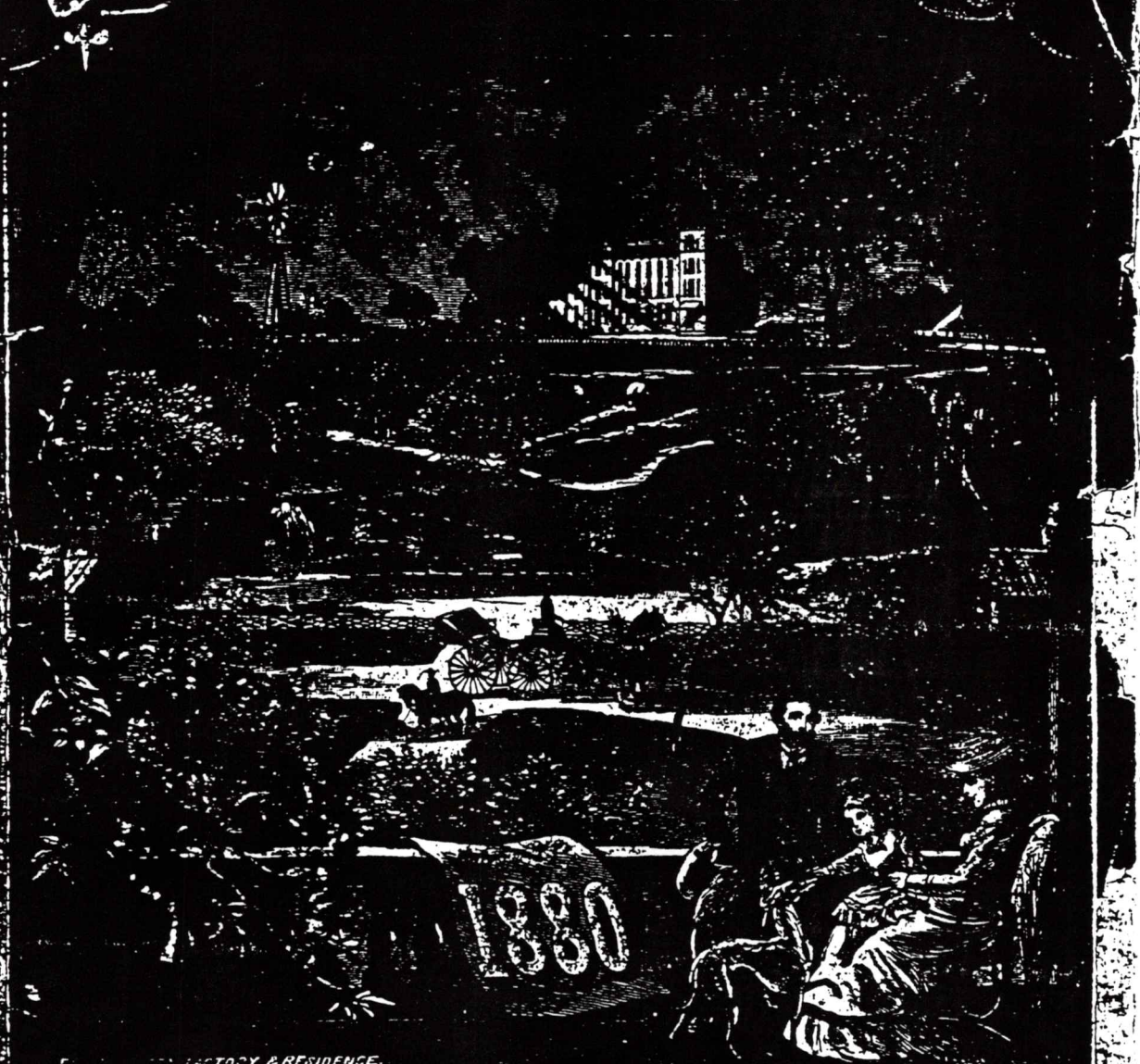

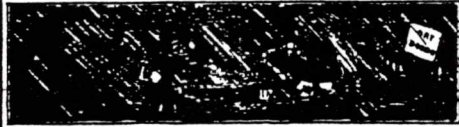

Dear Cousin Dorothy,

Thank you again for your letter of the 20th. It is always good to hear from kinfolk. I try to keep in touch with those that I know. Grandfather Henry Mincey died when mother was only about seven years of age. The old home place is near Portal, Georgia. Aunt Ethel Williams lives there.

Grandfather owned a huge plot of land there one time, and he was buried in a family graveyard on the farm but as the years went by the land was sold to many different people. A highway runs right by the graves now. There are markers on the graves. They are within about two miles from Portal. If you should ever be in that area, you travel Highway 80 from the center of Portal towards Twin City about one mile and turn right on Slate Road. I don't remember the number of the highway. Graves are on the shoulder of the road.

When I am there, I always go by and remove the weeds, etc., but I don't think they ever get any other attention, mainly because all other relatives live many miles away. I have a photo of Grandfather riding his horse named "Baldy," made in 1906. The head of the horse was solid white. This is why he was called "Baldy."

I am not sure of the origin of the name Mincey. I think it is English. I lived in England four years, and I noticed that Mincey is listed in the telephone directory. But it could be a derivation from French. Through heraldry, the name can probably be traced to the 14th century. My name on my father's side has been traced to Michealson, 14th century. It had changed to Mixon by the 16th century. Oxford University Campus was donated to Oxford in England by a man named C. F. Mixon, co-incidentally the same initials as my father. Strange isn't it?



(ALEXANDER MENZIES, Mincey) of Effingham County was listed in the 1782 Confiscation Act; when the 300 acres on the Ogeechee River was sold, the name was listed as Abraham. There were two people named Alexander Menzies in New Brunswick after the war. An ensign in the Loyal American Legion took a lot in Parrtown. Sarah Menzies was the widow of Major Alexander Menzies of the Third Regiment of DeLancey's Brigade. (1782 Ga. Confiscation Act; RRG I, 506; Wright, p. 305; PAC, NBLGP, York County, Petition of Alexander Menzies et al., 1784.)

JOHN MENZIES (Minzies) signed the petition of loyalists in Christ Church Parish in 1775. He was captain of a company of Georgia loyal militia. He went to New Brunswick as a member of the Loyal American Legion and received a Parrtown lot. (Christ Church memorial; Wright, p. 305; PAC, NBLGP, Northumberland County, Petition of John Menzies, 1788.)

ROBERT MOODIE (Moody) was a British native who settled in South Carolina in the early 1760's. He moved to Georgia and when the war began was a physician in Sunbury. Banished in 1777, he went to the West Indies and returned to Georgia when the British took Savannah. On the evacuation of Savannah, he went to Charles Town, where he became a surgeon for the Prince of Wales' American Regiment. He went with that group to New Brunswick and lived for a while in Fredericton. (Robert Moodie claim, A.O. 13:36; Christ Church memorial; Wright, p. 306.)

JOHN MURRAY, a native of Scotland, went to North Carolina to recover some of the property of a relative for whom Murray had given security. He bought and stocked a rice plantation in South Carolina. When the war began, he owned 100 acres in Chatham County, Georgia, and lived in Savannah. He went to Britain in 1776. He was in Georgia again

In 1785 he received 200 acres in Chester Township, Lunenburg County, and in 1787 he took 150 acres at Rawdon. (BMR, KCR; LC, Ga Loys; Fraser, Second Report, p. 60; Gilroy, pp. 61, 68.)

(JOHN MOORE) had the loyalist recruiter James Boyd into his Richmond County home in January 1779. He served in Andrew Hewat's companies of Georgia Loyalists and King's Carolina Rangers. In 1784 a man so named received fifty acres and a town lot at Shelburne. (NCA, Military Collection, Revolution, Miscellaneous Papers, Deposition of William Miller, 28 January, 1779; LC, Ga Loys; BMR, KCR; Gilroy, p. 95.)

(SAMUEL MOORE) of Effingham County was listed in the 1778 and 1782 Confiscation Acts. He served in the Georgia Loyalists. A Samuel Moore took two grants of 198 acres each in Wilmot Township, Annapolis County, in 1797. (1778 Ga. Confiscation Act; 1782 Ga. Confiscation Act; LC, Ga Loys; Gilroy, p. 18.)

WILLIAM MORRIS was a neighbor of Edward Crawford near the Ogeechee River. He served in the King's Carolina Rangers beginning in 1781 and went with the corps to East Florida and Nova Scotia. He took 100 acres at Country Harbour with the King's Carolina Rangers in 1784. He was living in Nova Scotia in 1786. Perhaps he was the William Morris who took 700 acres at Mahone Bay in 1784 and a town lot in Chester in 1788, both in Lunenburg County. (Fraser, Second Report, p. 715; BMR, KCR; Gilroy, pp. 68, 136; PANS, KCR warrant to survey, 23 April, 1784; LC Vol. 24, pp. 260-261.)

ARCHIBALD McDONALD moved from Scotland to St. Andrews Parish, just north of the Altamaha River, in 1756. The area became part of Liberty County in 1777. He owned 400 acres and produced rice and livestock. It was a Scottish area, and as late as 1787 McDonald spo-

This couple are definitely the ancestors of Dorothy Perry.

- 1..Abraham Mincey, b.c. 1730, (NC?), d. Screven Co. GA b.c. 1799, m. Patience Daughtry, b. 1756-60, d/o Michael
- 2..Shadrick Mincey, b.c. 1770-72, m. Jane (?), by Sept. 1795 they "were no longer man & wife" according to newspaper article
- 3..John Mincey, b. 1789, d. 1860, m.c. 1814 Celia Hendricks d/o John & Mary (R.S.)
- 4..Abraham Mincey, b. 1817, d. 1896, m. Elizabeth Ann Moore d/o John & Dicey

Family tradition says that John Moore, b. 1770-75 was brought to GA by "Granny Measles", so small he fit in a milk jug. Theory has been that this was Patience Mincey who m. 2) Luke Mizell (Measles) between 1801 & 1803. Could not be!! This woman not of an age to be John's granny...nor was she a Measles until 1801. Could the desc. telling this story have meant their "Granny" and not John's???? Or was John's "granny Measles" actually a Mizell of the previous generation????

Census records show Patience as b. 1750-1760. If 1750 correct then she only age 39 when John Mincey was born yet she stated he was her grandson & s/o Shadrick (who is believed to be her only child). She was age ca. 14-16 when Shadrick was born if the birth year of 1756 is correct (possible but not probable).

Abraham b.c. 1730 or before according to family researchers. That makes him 20-26 years older than Patience. Was she a 2nd wife???? He was a Loyalist and in St. Augustine, FL 1782 his lands having been confiscated. He later returned to GA and received more land. He had a land grant 1772 "bounded on S.E. by grantee" meaning he either bought or was granted land prior to that date. Supposedly came to GA from NC 1765-1770 with others..the first land record must be during that time period.

Patience (now m. to Luke Mizell) in 1803 gave a deed to grandson John, a minor. It would seem that if she had other grandchildren (such as John Moore) then she would also have deeded land to them. Has this been checked???

John Moore did end up with a lot of land which had belonged to Abraham (see deeds where he sold this later). How did he get this land? From Patience? From estate of Abraham? Needs checking.

One deed..Sarah Mizell to Luke Mizell 1789 needs checking. It has been assumed that this was Luke's sister giving him her share of land. BUT..could it have been Luke's Mother deeding him land from his father's estate which Sarah had inherited?? And if so..who was Sarah Mizell the widow of??? SHE was of an age to be the "Granny Measles" to bring John Moore to GA ca. 1770-75!!!!

Tradition...John Moore's mother died in childbirth..his father died in Rev. War and Granny Measles brought him to Ga "so small he fit in a milk jug"..

Fact...Rev. War began 1776...John would have been age 1 to age 6..definitely too old to fit in a milk jug!!! Could it be...when he was born he fit in that jug and not later when he was brought to GA??? OR could he have been born right here in GA? Maybe to Granny Measles daughter and been raised by Granny after mother died?

This tradition, as most do, probably has been twisted and changed through the years. Could it be...? & Sarah Mizell, of NC, later to GA, had a daughter ? who either married a Moore or had a child by a Moore who got killed in a battle prior to Rev. War (before or after he married her)...the daughter died when John was born and the Mizell's took him to raise. They later came to GA..they also had son Luke who Sarah Mizell gave land to 1789. In GA the Mizell's gave John the surname of his father, Moore. ?????????

Although the Mincey's nor the Mizell's were ever in Richmond Co.--John Moore m. Dicey daughter of William Sykes of Richmond Co. Where did he meet her?? HOW did he meet her? Sykes didn't have land in Effingham, Scriven Cos.---John supposedly lived in those counties always.

George Newton (R.S) m. Nancy Moore. He b. 1742 according to DAR records and served in NC. Nancy Moore supposedly the Aunt of John Moore. He later to GA.

A Patrick Newton, b. 1748 served NC also, m. Mary Moore..another Aunt???

It would seem that a search of NC records is needed in the areas where there were Newton's, Mizell's, Mincey's, and Moore's. This the only way to determine the possible parentage of John Moore, b. 1770-75 and later of Scriven Co., GA and died there 1837. These same families were closely associated with each other in GA.. settling and owning land and intermarrying . What is the connection? From the same area of NC??

Also...who was the 1st wife of Luke Mizell who m. 2) Patience (Daughtrey) Mincey, widow of Abraham?? Could she have been a Moore?? Was Luke's mother a Moore?? He about age 45 in 1801..surely had been married before. Any children from #1???

ADDITIONAL DATA

Re: 1st wife of Luke Mizell

She was Susannah(Sukey) (JONES) DIXON, widow of Rev. War soldier Robert Dixon, b.c. 1750, d. after 10 Sept. 1783..1 Lt. GA

Susannah was married to Luke Mizell by Dec. 1793 when her daughter Elizabeth Dixon m. Bird Lanier s/o Benjamin

Re: possible death data for Shadrack Mincey s/o Abraham Mincey & Patience Daughtrey. Michael Daughtrey, father of Patience, dated his will 3 May 1798...in it he made bequests to several grandchildren BUT Shadrack was not mentioned. The possibility exists that Shadrack had died prior to the writing of this 1798 will of his grandfather.

Because of the wording in the Savannah paper Sept. 1795, Shadrack and Jane are "no longer man and wife", the assumption was that there was a divorce. Is it possible that Shadrack had died and this notice was inserted in the paper so that any of his creditors would leave Jane alone?

his father asked for 200 acres of land on Horse Creek in March 1771 stating, "has wife and one child". Since Abraham and Patience only had the one child, Shadrack, then he was at least born by March 1771.
