

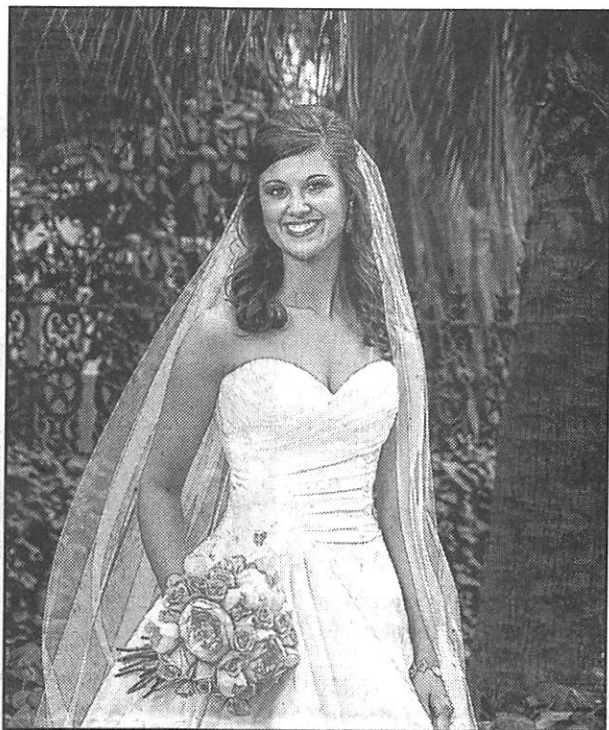
WEDDINGS
