

David Mabry Mobley inherited  
200 acres of land near Purity  
and built a splendid antebellum  
home in 1856. His father, Ed-  
ward, came from England. The  
house was occupied in succession  
by David Mobley, William Dixon  
Mobley, a Civil War soldier,  
and Mrs. J. W. Sill until the  
house burned in 1926. The  
Caldwells of Chester are of this  
line.
