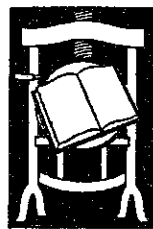

Died, in Sumter District, S. C., Mr. Peter Jayroe...born March 8, 1789, baptized by Rev. H. W. Mahoney, Sept. 1838, at which time he united with the Calvary Baptist Church...removed his membership to Fellowship Church, nearer his residence...died 28 May 1852....left widow and five children.

Issue of September 8, 1852

Married in Darlington, S. C., on the 17th of Dec., by Rev. J. O. B. Dargan, Prof. W. T. Walters of Wake Forest College, N. C., to Miss J. O. Wingate, of the former place.

Issue of May 5, 1857

Decease of Mrs. Tilatha Fore, consort of Dr. Willis Fore, of Marion District, S. C....

Issue of May 19, 1857

Died, in Fairfield District, on the 4th of last March, Mrs. Catharine Mobley, consort of Mr. David Mobley, in the 44th year of her age...eldest daughter of the late Samuel Dixon, of Kershaw District...member of the Baptist Church at Woodward...later at Chester C. H....

Issue of May 26, 1857

Died in Kansas City, Mo., 7th inst., Ida, daughter of Mr. C. M. and Mrs. M. E. Root, aged 14 months.

Issue of June 2, 1857

Died, at Society Hill, S. C., on Sunday, the 10th inst., Mrs. Sarah Ann Lacoste, wife of Mr. A. P. Lacoste, in the 33d year of her age...member of Black Creek Baptist Church...left husband, brother and four sisters.

Issue of June 9, 1857

Departed this life in Marlboro District, May the 23d, Mrs. Mary Hinson, in the 47th year of her age....

Departed this life suddenly, on the 4th May last, at his residence in Barnwell District, S. C., Jacob Foreman, Sr., in his 74th year...left widow and seven surviving children.

Died on the 23d of April last, at the residence of her brother-in-law, Rev. S. G. Mason, Halifax Co., Va., Mrs. V. Marable, wife of Rev. B. F. Marable.... Greenville, S. C., May 29.

In Burke Co., Ga., on the 12th of May, in the 58th year of her age, Sister Sarah Sapp. She was a native of South Carolina, married and moved to this county about 33 years ago....

Died on the first of Nov., 1862, Susan Telulah Josephine, daughter of William and N. E. Kelly, aged eleven months and 16 days....

Issue of December 17, 1862

Married on the 4th inst., by the Rev. J. W. Burn, at the residence of the bride's father, Mr. John Douglass to Miss Margaret D., fifth daughter of James Hill, all of Darlington district, S. C.

Death of Lieut. Richard Thomas Sanders, on the 12th October 1862, at Secessionville, aged 27 years....

Issue of December 24, 1862

Married on the 11th inst., at the residence of the bride's father, by Rev. D. W. Cuttino, Mr. W. H. Cuttino, of Hampton's Legion, to Miss E. A. Connors, youngest daughter of Col. T. H. Connors, of Clarendon, S. C.

Married, in this city, on the 17th inst., by the Rev. J. M. C. Breaker, Mr. Robert S. Green, to Miss Rosa Crabbin.

Died after an illness of five weeks, near Charlottesville, Va., on the 21st of September, 1862, Lieut. John Sloan, of Anderson C. H., S. C., in the 38th year of his age...remains interred in the Baptist church yard at Anderson...(long account and eulogy).

Amos A. Nettles, Esq., departed this life on Wednesday, 26th of Nov., in the 62d year of his age...born March 7, 1801, and was a deacon of the Sumter Baptist Church. (long eulogy).

Died at the residence of his mother, in Barnwell district, on the 11th of November, Richard W. Odom....

Died at the residence of her father, in Winn parish, La., on the 29th of July 1862, Ellen, only child of Col. N. J. and Indiana Walker, formerly residents of Barnwell district, in the 2nd year of her age.

James E. Lide, second son of Mr. E. J. Lide, of Darlington, died at his father's house on the 30th of November, 1862.... Capt. McIntosh's artillery....

Issue of January 7, 1863

Married, on the 23d of December, 1862 by Rev. J. T. Zealy, Mr. John W. Durham, of Fairfield district, to Miss Minnie W. Mobley, of Chester District.

Married on the 10th of December, 1862, by Rev. W. J. Lunn, Calvin Hide to Miss Harriet Redie, all of Darlington District, S. C.

Sergeant A. Y. McNeely, son of William and Lavenia McNeely, and a member of Co. E., Capt. R. T. Rodd's, 3d Regt., S. C. V., was killed in the battle of Sharpsburg, September 17, 1862 in the 25th year of his age....

In Memoriam...James E. Lide...junior in Furman University. Died on the 26th of November, 1862, Cornelia F. Brooks, daughter of Rev. Iveson L. and Sarah J. Brooks, of Woodville, near Hamburg, S. C....

Issue of November 18, 1863

Married on the 5th inst., at the residence of the bride's father, in Augusta county, Va., by Rev. G. Washington Hicks, chaplain C. S. A., Simeon E. Miller, of Barnwell District, S. C., to Miss Maggie A. S. Hawpe.

Died, in the Howard Grove Hospital, Richmond, Va., on the 29th July 1863, in the 20th year of his age, William Henry Jordan, of Cheraw, S. C....

Departed this life, October 5, 1863, in Orangeburg District, S. C., Miss Cornelia J. Brodie, eldest daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Robert Brodie, in the 25th year of her age....

Issue of November 25, 1863

Married at the residence of the bride's father, in Greenville dist., S. C., on Tuesday evening, the 17th inst., by Rev. A. Rice, Sergeant Jesse S. McGee of Abbeville dist., to Miss Mary A. Charles, daughter of Isreal Charles.

By the same, on Sept. the 1st, Mr. James A. Brownlee, of Abbeville dist., S. C., to Miss Mary J. Harkness, of Anderson dist.

Died, at Rock Hill, October 20, 1863, Johnnie, son of Lieut. W. L. and Mrs. L. V. Robertson, aged 1 year, 1 month and 26 days.

Died, on the 5th inst., infant daughter of S. A. and V. C. Wilson, aged 8 days....

Mr. David Layton, of Spartanburg District, S. C., volunteered Dec. 11, 1861...member of Capt. Nesbitt's co., 1st Regt. S. C. Cavalry...killed Sept. 13, 1863 near Culpepper, C. H., in the 23rd year of his age....left a widow mother, brothers and sisters.

Issue of December 2, 1863

Killed on the battle field one mil South of Culpepper C. H., Va., on the 13th of Sept., Mr. David P. Layton, aged 22 years, 11 months and 7 days....

Died, on the morning of the 30th October, at the residence of her father in Newberry district, Mrs. Theresa O. Williams, wife of Col. John G. Williams, of Spring Grove, Laurens District. (long eulogy).

Died at her father's residence in Spartanburg district, S. C., on 12th August, 1863, in the 6th year of her age, little Louisa Victory Lanford, only daughter of Landrum Landford and his wife Leanna Jane....

Died, at the residence of his father in Barnwell district, Wm. S. Williams, aged 19 years, 7 months and 3 days...born March 1, 1844....

Issue of December 9, 1863

Died, in the city of Charleston, Roper hospital, Joseph D. Phillips, in the 26th year of his age...son of Isaac Phillips, of Union District, S. C., who is a deacon of Mount Ararat church.

Departed this life in Newberry District, 15 Nov., at 2 O'clock p. m., Mrs. Mary E. Mobley, consort of Dr. J. R. Mobley, and daughter of Col. B. F. Griffin, of Newberry district, having just entered her 36th year....member of Old Bush River church and later Dry Creek Church...

Departed this life at Long Town, on 27th Nov., Mary Altona,
