PETITIONS FOR LAND FROM SOUTH CAROLINA COUNCIL JOURNALS

[Meeting of Tuesday A. M. 5 September 1758]

Pages 23-24: A Petition of John Murray Esq'r for 1000 acres of Land on Savanna River opposite to Augusta commonly called the Chickesaw Camp, which Land having been reserved by an order of Council for the use of the Chickesaws.

The Hon'ble William Bull observed, that tho it appeared from the Conference held between him and the Chickesaws at Fort Moore the 20th day of July last, and communicated by his Excellency to the council that the Chickesaws had surrendered their Claim to the said Land, yet it was upon Condition that they were put in Possession of 1500 acres of Land in Georgia and this province belonging to Mr. Lachlan McGillivray of Augusta. That Mr. McGillivray had agreed to surrender to this government for the use of the Chickesaws, the said Tracts of 1500 acres belonging to him in Georgia and this province, and to make such Titles thereunto to this Government as should be required of him... It was thereupon Order'd that the former order of Council to stay the proceedings upon any Warrants of Survey laid out upon the Land possessed by the Chickesaws opposite to Augusta be strictly observed, and that no further survey be made thereupon untill a survey is made of 1500 acres of Land for Mr. McGillivray.

Page 28: A Petition of Joseph Miles for a Re-survey of a Tract of 640 acres of Land in Colleton County belonging to him and a Survey of any Vacant Land that joins the said Tract, that the same with the surplus Land in the said Tract (if any) might be Certified to him upon his proving his family Right thereto; which Petition being considered the prayer thereof was granted.
