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9, 27: John Kalson, 250 acres on the south side of Santee River in Berkley County surveyed 9 Aug 1757 for the said Kalson adj. land of Scott deceased, 22 Jan 1759. Plat certified 5 Sept 1758. Delivered to himself 22 March 1759.

9, 28: Robert Johnston, 200 acres on the north side of Saluda River on a branch of Little River, 22 Jan 1759. Plat certified 6 June 1758.

9, 29: Peter June, 450 acres on Santee Swamp in Craven County adj. Col. Waries, Jane Duprey, Mathew Drake, James Sinclair, 22 Jan 1759. Plat certified 3 Oct 1758.

9, 30: Arthur Patton, 250 acres on a Place called the Mill Seat on the north west fork of the Long Cane in Granville County, 22 Jan 1759. Plat certified 7 Oct 1758. 17th March 1759 d'd to Patrick Calhoun.

9, 31: Mary Noble, 300 acres on a Place called Cane Hill on the north west fork of the Long Cane in Granville County, adj. Ezekiel Calhoun, 22 Jan 1759. Plat certified 30 Aug 1758. 17th March 1759 d'd to Patrick Calhoun.

9, 32: Thomas Jones, 250 acres on the High Hills on the North East side of Santee River in Craven County adj. James Michie Esqr., George Sanders, 22 Jan 1759. Plat certified 8 Nov 1753.

9, 33: Francis McCall, 150 acres between the Main Branch of Duncans Creek and Bush River near the Head of the said River, 22 Jan 1759. Plat certified 27 May 1758.

9, 34: Alexander McCauley, 200 acres on the west side of Edisto River known by the name of Hole Swamp in Colleton County adj. George Jackson, 22 Jan 1759. Plat certified 16 July 1756.

9, 35: John Lane, 200 acres on the north side of the Congree River near opposite to the entrance of Beaver Creek surveyed 22 July 1756 for Gilbert Gibson, 22 Jan 1759. Plat certified 5 Sept 1758.

9, 36: William Mobley, 100 acres on the north side of Broad River on a branch of the same Called Beaver Creek, 22 Jan 1759. Plat certified 3 Oct 1758. D'd to the owner 3 April 1759.

9, 37: James Miles, 350 acres at the High Hills on the Waters of Santee in Craven County, 22 Jan 1759. Plat certified 10 April 1756. Delivered to the Auditor 4 Dec 1759.

9, 38: James Lord, 400 acres on Butlers Branch on the north side of Santee River in Craven County adj. John Boles, 22 Jan 1759. Plat certified 7 Nov 1758.

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9, 328: James Donnom, 735 acres on the east side of the North Branch of the Head of Combahee River in St. Bartholomews Parish in Colleton County adj. Samuel and Joseph Wrag, said James Donnom, land formerly belonging unto Campbell but now to said James Donnom, David Allen, John and William Peters, 20 Feb 1760. Plat certified 21 June 1759.

9, 329: Joseph White, 235 acres on Jeffreys Creek in Craven County, 4 March 1760. Plat certified 7 Nov 1758.

9, 330: John Messer, 400 acres on the north west fork of the Long Canes between Saluda and Savannah Rivers in Granville county adj. William Calhoun, 4 March 1760. Plat certified 5 Dec 1758.

9, 331: William Dargen, 150 acres on the north side of Congaree or Santee River, 4 March 1760. Plat certified 5 Feb 1760.

9, 332: Hugh Calhoun, 100 acres on the waters of the north fork of the Long Cane, being the waters of Savannah River in Granville County adj. William Calhoun, 20 Feb 1760. Plat certified 7 Dec 1758.

9, 333: James McCulloch, 200 acres at Long Cane fording place in Granville County, 20 Feb 1760. Plat certified 23 Dec 1758.

9, 334: William Mobley, 200 acres on the north east side of Broad River on a branch of said river called Little Creek in Craven County, 20 Feb 1760. Plat certified 4 Nov 1758.

9, 335: George Rawlinson, 250 acres in the fork of Santee and Wateree Rivers, 4 March 1760. Plat certified 5 Dec 1758.

9, 336: Thomas Jernegen, 200 acres on both sides of Cados Lake on the north side of Santee River in Craven county adj. Jared Nelson deceased, Joseph Howard, 4 March 1760. Plat certified 7 Nov 1758.

9, 337: Jeremiah Warren, 100 acres between the forks of Broad and Saluda Rivers on a branch of Bush River, the waters of Saluda River, 4 March 1760. Plat certified 6 March 1759.

9, 338: Peter Lessene, 250 acres on the north side of Santee River in Craven County, surveyed 11 July 1758 for said Peter Lessene, adj. John Phillips, Peter Robert, John McDonald, 20 Feb 1760. Plat certified 7 Aug 1759.

9, 339: William Beverly, 150 acres on Cat Fish in Craven County, 4 March 1760. Plat certified 7 Nov 1758.

9, 340: Thomas West, 500 acres on the north west side of Peedee River in Craven County adj. William Reed, William Bell, Joseph Pye, 20 Feb 1760. Plat certified 25 June 1757.

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9, 341: William Mobley, 150 acres on the north side of Broad River on a branch thereof called Little Creek in Craven County, 4 March 1760. Plat certified 13 April 1759.

9, 342: Charles Carson, 250 acres on a branch of Little River, 20 Feb 1760. Plat certified 1 May 1759.

9, 343: Joseph Glover, 100 acres on the Foot of Bear Branch on the branches of Saltcatcher River in Colleton County, 4 March 1760. Plat certified 10 Nov [no year indicated].

9, 344: James McNaught, 300 acres on the north west fork of Long Cane in Granville County adj. James Kerr, 4 March 1760. Plat certified 29 Dec 1758.

9, 345: David Stevens, 500 acres on a place known by the name of Goodland Swamp in Colleton County adj. Jacob Stevens, 4 March 1760. Plat certified 26 June 1759.

9, 346: Joseph Teller, 100 acres on the south fork of Lynch's Creek in Craven County, 4 March 1760. Plat certified 17 Feb 1759.

9, 347: Thomas Reeves, 100 acres on the north west side of the western branch of North Edisto River on a branch called Pettys pond Branch in Colleton County, 20 Feb 1760. Plat certified 14 Feb 1759.

9, 348: Charles Robinson, 100 acres on the forks between Broad River and Saluda River on a branch of Saluda called Cane Creek in Berkley County, surveyed 29 Oct 1757 for the said Robinson, 20 Feb 1760. Plat certified 3 Oct 1758.

9, 349: Peter Rumph, 12 3/4 acres in St. Bartholomews Parish in Colleton County adj. Presbytorean parsonage, John Martin, William Oswald, William Smith, 4 March 1760. Plat certified 10 July 1759.

9, 350: James Conyers, 100 acres on the north side of Black River in Craven County adj. James Conyers, 4 March 1760. Plat certified 1 May 1759.

9, 351: Francis Brice, 100 acres on a branch of Edisto River at the place called Brices Branch, 20 Feb 1760. Plat certified 6 Dec 1758.

9, 352: Thomas Holmes, 100 acres in the forks of Saltcatcher River in Colleton County, 4 March 1760. Plat certified 1 May 1759.

9, 353: Francis Whittington, 50 acres on the north east side of Peedee River and south side of Muddy Creek in the Welch Tract, Craven County, 4 March 1760. Plat certified 5 Dec 1758.
