Scope & Content / Abstract:

One of several hundred documents removed from an old safe, once the property of dr. Charles Spencer McCants; the locked safe became the property of Lily Fox when she and her husband bought hte McCants house in the 1990s; when Mrs. Fox died in 2014, the safe was opened udner the direction of one of Mrs. Fox's executors; the contents were shipped to Nell McCants Smith, daughter of Dr. McCants, in Beaufort, SC; after reviewing the items, Mrs. Smith shipped and donated them to the Fairfield County Historical Society Collection at the Fairfield County Museum

Last Will and Testament of John Mobley, Sr., planter, of the District of Fairfield, dated May 11, 1864; unsigned; includes witnesses G.H. Miller, J.A. Brice, and John McLurkin; bequests made to wife Catherine Mobley and children Simon Mobley, Dorcas Mobley McCrorey, Catherine E.
